7 **A Resolution confirming the award by the Board of Control of a professional service**  
8 **contract with Oriana House, Inc., as a Best Practical Source, for two full-time case**  
9 **managers and one full-time recovery support specialist, to provide support and treatment**  
10 **services to Valor Court participants, for a one-year term, from 9/30/21 through 9/29/22, in**  
11 **an amount not to exceed \$216,388.49, for the Court of Common Pleas-General Division,**  
12 **Adult Probation, and declaring an emergency.**

13  
14 WHEREAS, this Council previously adopted Resolution No. 2020-091, which confirmed  
15 the award by the Board of Control of a professional service contract with Oriana House, Inc., as  
16 a Best Practical Source, for two full-time case managers and one full-time recovery support  
17 specialist, to provide support and treatment services to Valor Court participants, for a one-year  
18 term, from 9/30/19 through 9/29/20, in an amount not to exceed \$210,332.00; and

20 WHEREAS, this Council subsequently adopted Resolution No. 2021-015, which  
21 confirmed the award by the Board of Control of a professional service contract with Oriana  
22 House, Inc., as a Best Practical Source, for two full-time case managers and one full-time  
23 recovery support specialist, to provide support and treatment services to Valor Court participants,  
24 for a one-year term, from 9/30/20 through 9/29/21, in an amount not to exceed \$216,388.49; and

26 WHEREAS, based on performance reviews and Oriana House Inc.'s specialized  
27 knowledge and previous years working with the Valor Court, the Court of Common Pleas-  
28 General Division, Adult Probation, wishes to enter into a professional service contract with  
29 Oriana House, Inc., as a Best Practical Source, for a one-year term, from 9/30/21 through  
30 9/29/22, in an amount not to exceed \$216,388.49, to be funded by a Fiscal Year 2022 Treatment  
31 Drug Courts grant from the United States Department of Health and Human Services, Substance  
32 Abuse and Mental Health Services Administration ("SAMSHA") for the Valor Court Expansion  
33 and Enhancement Project; and

35 WHEREAS, the Board of Control, at its meeting held August 18, 2021, awarded said  
36 professional service contract with Oriana House, Inc., as a Best Practical Source, for a one-year  
37 term, from 9/30/21 through 9/29/22, in an amount not to exceed \$216,388.49, subject to  
38 confirmation by Council; and

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40 WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information,  
41 that the aforementioned renewal of the professional service contract with Oriana House, Inc. is  
42 necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit;

49 The award by the Board of Control of a professional service contract with Oriana House,  
50 Inc., as a Best Practical Source, for two full-time case managers and one full-time recovery  
51 support specialist, to provide support and treatment services to Valor Court participants, for a  
52 one-year term, from 9/30/21 through 9/29/22, in an amount not to exceed \$216,388.49, is hereby

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9 SECTION 2

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11 This Resolution is declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety, and welfare  
12 of the residents of the County of Summit, and for the further reason that it immediately  
13 authorizes necessary support and treatment services for Valor Court participants.

15 SECTION 3

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17 Provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of eight members, it shall take  
18 effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Executive; otherwise, it shall take  
19 effect and be in force at the earliest time provided by law.

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21 SECTION 4

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23 It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating  
24 to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all  
25 deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were  
26 in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section  
27 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.


