A Resolution declaring the month of October 2021 as National Arts and Humanities Month in Summit County, for the Executive, and declaring an emergency.

WHEREAS, the nation's 95,000 nonprofit arts organizations, the National Endowment for the Arts, the National Endowment for the Humanities, the nation's 4,500 local arts agencies, and the arts and humanities councils of the 50 states and the six U.S. jurisdictions have regularly issued official proclamations on an annual basis designating October as National Arts and Humanities Month; and

WHEREAS, in Summit County, ArtsNow works with arts, humanities and cultural organizations across the County to support and strengthen the region's economic and social vibrancy; and

WHEREAS, the arts and humanities enhance and enrich the lives of every resident of Summit County; and

WHEREAS, there are over 1,100 arts-related businesses in Summit County that employ 882 people and play a unique role in the lives of individuals, families, and our 31 communities; and

WHEREAS, cities, counties, and states, through their local and state arts agencies and representing thousands of cultural organizations, have celebrated the value and importance of culture in the lives of Americans and the health of thriving communities during National Arts and Humanities Month for several years; and

WHEREAS, the humanities help diverse communities across Summit County explore their history and culture with the support and partnership of the National Endowment for the Humanities, the 56 state and territorial humanities councils, and local educational and cultural institutions such as Arts Now, Summit ArtSpace, and the Akron Art Museum; and

WHEREAS, the creative economy generates \$1.4 billion in the Akron Metropolitan Statistical Area, which includes Summit and Portage Counties, supports 17,608 jobs, and supplies more than \$768 million in wages and proprietor income;

WHEREAS, the creative economy drives tourism and commerce, supports American workers, and significantly contributes to the local economy;

WHEREAS, arts and humanities organizations have been dramatically impacted by the Coronavirus Disease 2019 ("COVID-19") pandemic and need the support of the community more than ever;

WHEREAS, Summit County has demonstrated its support for arts, humanities and cultural organizations by allocating \$1.5 million of Coronavirus Aid, Relief and Economic Security Act ("CARES Act") funds to arts, humanities and cultural organizations through the Non-Profit Grant Program;
