An Ordinance amending Section 339.12 of the Codified Ordinances of the County of Summit, entitled "Bridge Weight Limits," to place load limits on the Snyder Avenue Bridge over the Tuscarawas River, the Ira Road Bridge over the North Fork of Yellow Creek, the Mt. Pleasant Road Bridge over Nimisila Creek, and the Wheatley Road Bridge over Riding Run, and to reduce the weight limit for the Christman Road Bridge over the Nimisila Reservoir, for the Engineer, and declaring an emergency.
WHEREAS, Section 339.12 of the Codified Ordinances of the County of Summit entitled "Bridge Weight Limits," limits the gross weight of vehicles authorized to travel on certain bridges that are inspected by the Engineer; and
WHEREAS, due to recent bridge inspections and load ratings conducted by Arcadis U.S. Inc, the Engineer concludes that a load limit should be placed on the Snyder Avenue Bridge over Tuscarawas River, located in the City of Barberton, Council District 7, the Ira Road Bridge over North Fork of Yellow Creek, located in Bath Township, Council Districts 4 and 5, the Mt. Pleasant Road Bridge over Nimisila Creek, located in the City of Green, Council District 8, the Wheatley Road Bridge over Riding Run, located in Richfield Township, Council District 1, and to reduce the current load limit on the Christman Road Bridge over Nimisila Reservoir, located in the City of Green, Council District 8; and
WHEREAS, the placement and removal of the load limits requires the amendment of Section 339.12 of the Codified Ordinances of the County of Summit; and
WHEREAS, this Council has determined by reviewing all pertinent information that the acceptance and approval of the aforementioned amendment to Section 339.12 of the Codified Ordinances of the County of Summit is necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit;
NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the County of Summit, State of Ohio, that;
SECTION 1
Section 339.12 of the Codified Ordinances of the County of Summit, entitled "Bridge Weight Limits," is amended as follows:
"339.12 BRIDGE WEIGHT LIMITS. (a) No person shall operate any vehicle upon any of the following bridges, if such vehicle, the gross weight of which, exceeds the maximum load limit specified for each respective bridge:

on a first offense; on a second offense within one year after the first offense, the person is guilty

of a misdemeanor of the fourth degree; on each subsequent offense within one year after the

second offense, the person is guilty of a misdemeanor of the third degree."

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SECTION 2

This Ordinance is hereby declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety and welfare of the residents of the County of Summit, and for the further reason to immediately amend Section 339.12 of the Codified Ordinances of the County of Summit allowing local officials to enforce bridge load limits and keep Summit County motorists safe.

SECTION 3

Provided this Ordinance receives the affirmative vote of eight members, it shall take effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Executive; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force at the earliest time provided by law.

SECTION 4

It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
