7 **A Resolution confirming the award by the Board of Control of a purchase contract with**  
8 **Ganley Ford, Inc. for the purchase of seven 2022 Ford Explorer police interceptor models,**  
9 **at less than CUE pricing, in an amount not to exceed \$237,106.66, for the Sheriff, and**  
10 **declaring an emergency.**

11  
12 WHEREAS, it is necessary periodically to replace worn vehicles for use by the Sheriff's  
13 Office; and

14  
15 WHEREAS, this Council previously adopted Resolution No. 2021-037 which allocated  
16 funds for replacement vehicle purchases for the Sheriff as part of the Capital Improvements  
17 program for 2021-2026; and

18  
19 WHEREAS, the Board of Control, at its meeting held September 22, 2021, awarded a  
20 purchase contract with Ganley Ford, Inc. for the purchase of seven 2022 Ford Explorer police  
21 interceptor models, at less than CUE pricing, in an amount not to exceed \$237,106.66, subject to  
22 confirmation by this Council; and

23  
24 WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information,  
25 that the aforementioned purchase contract with Ganley Ford, Inc. is necessary and in the best  
26 interest of the County of Summit;

28 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State  
29 of Ohio, that:

31 SECTION 1

33 The award by the Board of Control of a purchase contract with Ganley Ford, Inc. for the  
34 purchase of seven 2022 Ford Explorer police interceptor models, at less than CUE pricing, in an  
35 amount not to exceed \$237,106.66, is hereby confirmed and the Executive is hereby authorized to  
36 execute said purchase contract and any other necessary related documents.

38 SECTION 2

40 This Resolution is hereby declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety and  
41 welfare of the residents of the County of Summit, and for the further reason to immediately provide  
42 for necessary law enforcement vehicles for the Sheriff.

44 SECTION 3

46 Provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of eight members, it shall take effect  
47 immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Executive; otherwise, it shall take effect and  
48 be in force at the earliest time provided by law.



9 of the Ohio Revised Code.


