18 19	WHEREAS, that amendment requires that "the Council shall appoint five electors of the County, not more than three of whom shall be members of the same political party and none of whom shall hold public office or be an officer of a political party, who shall constitute" the Commission and although "political party" has a clear meaning, "public office" is not a term defined within the section, or otherwise clearly defined at law; and
