### SECTION 1

A drainage maintenance fund for The Retreat at Liberty Lakes Subdivision Phase 1, in Twinsburg Township, in Council District 1, is hereby revised.

### **SECTION 2**

Owners of parcels within the The Retreat at Liberty Lakes Subdivision Phase 1 shall be assessed for drainage maintenance, as set forth in the revised special assessment worksheet, attached to this Resolution as Exhibit A and incorporated fully herein. Each assessment is proportional to the estimated benefit to the respective parcel.

## **SECTION 3**

Owners of parcels within The Retreat At Liberty Lakes Subdivision Phase 2 shall be assessed for drainage maintenance per the special assessment worksheet, a copy of which is attached as Exhibit B and incorporated fully herein. Each assessment is proportional to the estimated benefit to the respective parcel.

### **SECTION 4**

Pursuant to Section 6137.03 of the Ohio Revised Code, the Clerk of Council shall certify the attached assessments to the Fiscal Officer for placement on the next succeeding tax duplicate to be collected and paid.

# **SECTION 5**

This Resolution is hereby declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety, and welfare of the residents of the County of Summit, and for the further reason to immediately fund necessary drainage maintenance in The Retreat at Liberty Lakes Subdivision Phase 1 and to assess residents of Phase 2 of said subdivision for necessary drainage maintenance, located in Twinsburg Township, in Council District 1.

## **SECTION 6**

Provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of eight members, it shall take effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Executive; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force at the earliest time provided by law.
