7 **A Resolution confirming the award by the Board of Control of Change Order No. 1 to a**
8 **professional service contract with Child Guidance and Family Solutions to provide**
9 **prevention and intervention services for preschool aged children, in an amount not to**
10 **exceed \$32,000.00 (for a cumulative increase of 32%), for a total amount not to exceed**
11 **\$132,000.00, for the Executive's Department of Job and Family Services, and declaring an**
12 **emergency.**

14 WHEREAS, this Council previously adopted Resolution No. 2020-242, which confirmed
15 the award by the Board of Control of a professional service contract with Child Guidance and
16 Family Solutions to provide prevention and intervention services for preschool aged children, in
17 an amount not to exceed \$100,000.00, which is funded by Temporary Assistance to Needy
18 Families monies; and

20 WHEREAS, due to increased health care premium costs and expanded staffing needs for
21 providing services under pandemic conditions, the Executive has determined that the contract
22 requires additional funds; and

24 WHEREAS, the Board of Control, at its October 13, 2021 meeting, awarded Change
25 Order No. 1 to the professional service contract with Child Guidance and Family Solutions, in an
26 amount not to exceed \$32,000.00 (for a cumulative increase of 32%), for a total amount not to
27 exceed \$132,000.00; and

29 WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information,
30 that Change Order No. 1 to a professional service contract with Child Guidance and Family
31 Solutions, is necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit;

33 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State

39 contract with Child Guidance and Family Solutions to provide prevention and intervention

41 increase of 32%), for a total amount not to exceed \$132,000.00, is hereby confirmed and the
42 Executive is hereby authorized to execute said change order and any necessary related
43 documents.


