7 **A Resolution confirming the award by the Board of Control of a purchase contract with**
8 **Buckeye Power Sales, in an amount not to exceed \$124,125.00, for an additional 5-month**
9 **rental of a backup generator and equipment as a result of an emergency declaration**
10 **pursuant to Cod. Ord.177.07(a)(3), for the Executive’s Department of Sanitary Sewer**
11 **Services, and declaring an emergency.**

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13 WHEREAS, on July 15, 2021, a lightning strike occurred at the Fishcreek Waste Water
14 Treatment Plant (“WWTP”) No. 25, located in Stow, in Council District 3, which caused severe
15 damage to the primary electric feed, primary transformer, and switch gear; and

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17 WHEREAS, this Council previously adopted Resolution No. 2021-225, which declared
18 the lightning damage to WWTP No. 25 an emergency pursuant to Section 177.07(a)(3) of the
19 Codified Ordinances of the County of Summit, and authorized the Executive, subject to the
20 approval of the Board of Control, to execute a purchase contract with Sunbelt-Solomon
21 Solutions, in an amount not to exceed \$62,836.00, for an emergency purchase of a transformer;
22 and

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24 WHEREAS, the Board of Control, at its meeting held on August 4, 2021, awarded a
25 purchase contract to Sunbelt-Solomon Solutions for an emergency purchase of a transformer for
26 WWTP No. 25, in an amount not to exceed \$62,836.00; and

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28 WHEREAS, currently WWTP No. 25 is running on secondary power with no redundancy,
29 which is required to meet Ohio Environmental Protection Agency permit guidelines; and

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31 WHEREAS, rental equipment is needed to provide backup power should the secondary
32 power feed fail while the primary equipment is waiting for repair and replacement; and

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34 WHEREAS, the Board of Control, at its meeting held on August 4, 2021, awarded a
35 purchase contract to Buckeye Power Sales for a two-month rental for a backup generator for
36 WWTP No. 25, in an amount not to exceed \$49,650.00, while a new electrical transformer is
37 being built, delivered, and installed for use by the Executive’s Department of Sanitary Sewer
38 Services; and

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40 WHEREAS, it is now necessary to rent said equipment from Buckeye Power Sales for an
41 additional five-months; and

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43 WHEREAS, the Board of Control, at its meeting held on October 27, 2021, awarded a
44 purchase contract with Buckeye Power Sales, as an emergency pursuant to Section 177.07(a)(3)
45 of the Codified Ordinances of the County of Summit, for an additional five-month rental of a
46 backup generator and equipment for WWTP No. 25, in an amount not to exceed \$124,125.00;
47 and

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49 WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information,
50 that a purchase contract with Buckeye Power Sales for an additional five-month rental of a
51 backup generator and related equipment for WWTP No. 25 is necessary and in the best interest
52 of the County of Summit for the aforementioned reasons;

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4 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State
5 of Ohio, that:

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7 SECTION 1

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9 The award by the Board of Control of a purchase contract to Buckeye Power Sales, as an
10 emergency pursuant to Section 177.07(a)(3) of the Codified Ordinances of the County of
11 Summit, for an additional five-month rental of a backup generator and related equipment for use
12 by the Executive's Department of Sanitary Sewer Services at the Fishcreek Waste Water
13 Treatment Plant ("WTTP") No. 25, located in Stow, in Council District 3, in an amount not to
14 exceed \$124,125.00 is hereby confirmed and the Executive is hereby authorized to execute said
15 purchase contract and any other necessary related documents.

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17 SECTION 2

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19 This Resolution is hereby declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety, and
20 welfare of the residents of the County of Summit, and for the further reason to immediately
21 authorize a necessary purchase contract for an additional five-month rental of a backup generator
22 and related equipment for WWTP No. 25 while replacement equipment is being built.

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24 SECTION 3

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26 Provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of eight members, it shall take
27 effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Executive; otherwise, it shall take
28 effect and be in force at the earliest time provided by law.

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30 SECTION 4

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32 It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating
33 to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all
34 deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action,
35 were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section
36 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.


