	A Resolution confirming the award by the Board of Control of a construction contract with North Electric, Inc. for the Summit County Lighting Upgrade Project, in an amount not to exceed \$1,347,580.00, for the Executive's Department of Administrative Services—Physical Plants, and declaring an emergency.			
	WHEREAS, this Council previously approved Resolution Nos. 2020-317 and 2021-254, which confirmed the award by the Board of Control of a professional service contract with the GPD Group for design services for the Summit County Lighting Upgrade Project (the "Project"), in an amount not to exceed \$364,398.00; and			
	WHEREAS, there are 12 County Buildings, located Countywide, in various Counci Districts, that are illuminated with T8 fluorescent fixtures, which were the industry standard when the last County lighting efficiency projects were completed in 2008; and			
WHEREAS, the new standard for building illumination is LED light dramatically reduces energy costs as well as cooling costs as LED lights do not geneas much heat as T8 fluorescent fixtures; and				
	WHEREAS, LED lighting also dramatically reduces maintenance costs as LED lights last for up to 50,000 hours as opposed to 30,000 hours for the current fixtures; and			
	WHEREAS, it is estimated that the Project will pay for itself in 5 years due to above reference cost savings; and			
	WHEREAS, this Council subsequently adopted Resolution No. 2021-178, which authorizing the Executive to advertise for bids for the construction phase of the Project, for an estimated total cost not to exceed \$1,985,000.00; and			
	WHEREAS, after advertising for and reviewing bids, the Executive has selected North Electric, Inc. for the Project, in an amount not to exceed \$1,347,580.00; and			
	WHEREAS, the Board of Control, at its meeting held November 3, 2021, awarded a construction contract with North Electric, Inc., as the lowest responsive and responsible bidder for the Project, inn amount not to exceed \$1,347,580.00			
	WHEREAS, the Executive expects that the cost of the Project, including design, replacement and construction of services, will be reimbursed through the issuance of general obligation bonds at a future date; and			
	WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information, that the aforementioned construction contract with North Electric, Inc. is necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit;			
	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State of Ohio, that:			

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SECTION 1

The award by the Board of Control of a construction contract with North Electric, Inc. for the Summit County Lighting Upgrade Project, in an amount not to exceed \$1,347,580.00, is hereby confirmed and the Executive is hereby authorized to execute said construction contract and any other necessary related documents.

SECTION 2

This Council hereby makes the following declaration of official intent under United States Treasury Regulations for purposes of Sections 103 and 141 to 150 of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 (the "Internal Revenue Code"): This Council declares, on behalf of the County, that it reasonably expects the expenditures related to the design, replacement and construction of the Project will be reimbursed with the proceeds of bonds (as defined in Section 150 of the Internal Revenue Code). The maximum principal amount of bonds expected to be issued for the purpose described in this section 2 is not to exceed \$2,500,000.00.

SECTION 3

This Resolution is declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety, and welfare of the residents of the County of Summit, and for the further reason that it authorizes the Executive to immediately proceed with necessary lighting upgrades for 12 County Buildings.

SECTION 4

Provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of eight members, it shall take effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Executive; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force at the earliest time provided by law.

SECTION 5

It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
