7 **A Resolution authorizing the Executive and Engineer to apply for Federal Surface**
8 **Transportation Block Grant funds, Resurfacing Project funds, and Transportation**
9 **Alternatives Set Aside funds, programmed by the Akron Metropolitan Area**
10 **Transportation Study, in order to improve fourteen projects in Council Districts 1, 4, 5,**
11 **and 8, for the Engineer and declaring an emergency.**

13 WHEREAS, the Akron Metropolitan Area Transportation Study (“AMATS”) has issued
14 a notification seeking grant applications for projects eligible to receive Federal Surface
15 Transportation Block Grant (“STBG”) funds, Resurfacing Project funds, and Transportation
16 Alternatives Set Aside (“TASA”) funds; and

17
18 WHEREAS, the Engineer has identified fourteen different projects in Council Districts 1,
19 4, 5, and 8 that meet AMATS project criteria and guidelines, with project names and
20 descriptions, a copy of which is attached hereto as Exhibit A and incorporated fully herein; and

21
22 WHEREAS, the federal programs will provide up to 80% of the construction costs for the
23 projects, with a local cash match required; and

25 WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information,
26 that it is necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit to authorize the Executive
27 and the Engineer to apply for STBG, Resurfacing, and TASA funds programmed by AMATS to
28 improve fourteen projects in Council Districts 1, 4, 5, and 8;

30 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State
31 of Ohio, that:

33 SECTION 1

34
35 The Executive, on behalf of the County of Summit, is hereby authorized to apply for
36 Federal Surface Transportation Block Grant funds, Resurfacing Project funds, and
37 Transportation Alternative Set Aside funds programmed by the Akron Metropolitan Area
38 Transportation Study (“AMATS”) for fourteen projects identified in Exhibit A which is attached
39 hereto and incorporated fully herein,

41 SECTION 2

43 That the County of Summit acknowledges and understands the AMATS “Funding Policy
44 Guidelines” and confirms to the best of its knowledge that the information contained in the
45 project application is accurate, that it intends to diligently pursue that project, and that a local
46 share is required to match federal funds.

50 The Clerk of Council is instructed to provide two certified copies of this Resolution to the
51 Engineer, for submission to AMATS as part of the funding applications.

19 to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all
20 deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action,

22 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.


