7 **A Resolution amending Resolution No. 2021-243 to increase the amount of a renewal**
8 **(second and final) of a purchase contract with the Metro Regional Transit Authority, to**
9 **provide Non-Emergency Medical Transportation Broker services for a one-year term,**
10 **from 10/1/21 through 9/30/22, to a new amount not to exceed \$523,725.75, for the**
11 **Executive's Department of Job and Family Services, and declaring an emergency.**

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13 WHEREAS, this Council previously adopted Resolution No. 2019-470, which confirmed
14 the award by the Board of Control of a purchase contract with the Metro Regional Transit
15 Authority for Non-Emergency Medical Transportation ("NET") Broker services, for a one-year
16 term, from 1/1/20 through 9/30/20, in an amount not to exceed \$365,000.00; and

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18 WHEREAS, this Council subsequently adopted Resolution No. 2020-253, which
19 confirmed the award by the Board of Control of a renewal of the purchase contract with Metro
20 Regional Transit Authority for NET Broker services, for a one-year term, from 10/1/20 through
21 9/30/21, in an amount not to exceed \$456,250.00; and

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23 WHEREAS, this Council subsequently adopted Resolution No. 2021-243, which
24 confirmed the award by the Board of Control of a renewal (second and final) of the purchase
25 contract with Metro Regional Transit Authority for NET Broker services, for a one-year term,
26 from 10/1/21 through 9/30/22, in an amount not to exceed \$456,250.00; and

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28 WHEREAS, the renewal, which has not yet been executed, was renegotiated at a higher
29 amount due to the request by the Executive's Department of Job and Family Services ("DJFS")
30 to purchase and dispense driver computer tablets to DJFS contracted transportation providers, as
31 a function of Metro Regional Transit Authority broker services, for transportation
32 documentation, navigation and dispatch communications; and

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34 WHEREAS, the Board of Control, at its October 27, 2021 meeting, amended Directive
35 No. 221-21 to increase the amount of the purchase contract with the Metro Regional Transit
36 Authority to a new amount not to exceed \$523,725.75; and

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38 WHEREAS, the Executive wishes to amend Resolution No. 2021-243, to increase the
39 amount of the second renewal of the purchase contract with the Metro Regional Transit
40 Authority to a new amount not to exceed \$523,725.75; and

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42 WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information,
43 that it is necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit to amend Resolution No.
44 2021-243 for the aforementioned reasons;

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46 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State
47 of Ohio, that:

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4 SECTION 1

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6 Resolution No. 2021-243 is hereby amended to increase the amount of a renewal (second
7 and final) of a purchase contract with Metro Regional Transit Authority for Non-Emergency
8 Medical Transportation ("NET") Broker services, for a one-year term, from 10/1/21 through
9 9/30/22, to a new amount not to exceed \$523,725.75.

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11 SECTION 2

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13 This Resolution is declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety and welfare
14 of the residents of the County of Summit, and for the further reason to immediately amend
15 Resolution No. 2021-243 to increase the amount of the second renewal of the purchase contract
16 with the Metro Regional Transit so that the County can dispense driver computer tablets to
17 contracted transportation providers.

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19 SECTION 3

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21 Provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of eight members, it shall take
22 effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Executive; otherwise, it shall take
23 effect and be in force at the earliest time provided by law.

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25 SECTION 4

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27 It is found and determined that all formal actions of the Council concerning and relating
28 to the adoption of the Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all
29 deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action,
30 were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section
31 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
