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7 **A Resolution confirming the award by the Board of Control of a construction contract with**
8 **Workman Industrial Services, Inc. for the Miscellaneous Bridge/Culvert Repair Project to**
9 **repair culverts in Council Districts 1, 6 and 7, in an amount not to exceed \$252,366.00, for**
10 **the Engineer, and declaring an emergency.**

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12 WHEREAS, this Council previously adopted Resolution No. 2021-416, which authorized
13 the Executive to advertise for bids as necessary for bridge engineering and construction projects,
14 pavement maintenance and federally funded projects for the Engineer's 2021 Capital
15 Improvement Program, and federal and state funded projects at an estimated cost not to exceed
16 \$9,117,500.00; and

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18 WHEREAS, the Executive was authorized by Resolution No. 2021-416 to advertise for
19 bids for pavement, culvert, and ditch maintenance, in an amount not to exceed \$4,848,500.00, in
20 2021; and

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22 WHEREAS, the Engineer has proposed the Miscellaneous Bridge/Culvert Repairs
23 Project (the "Project"), which would repair the culverts listed in the table below, located in
24 Council Districts 1, 6 and 7, with the work consisting of surface preparation, dewatering, filling
25 voids, and pouring (field paving) 3 inches of reinforced concrete on the bottoms and sides of the
26 culverts, which would add another 20 to 25 years of useful life to the culverts, and slope
27 protection in erosion areas:

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40 WHEREAS, after advertising for bids, the Executive received bids from five firms and
41 selected Workman Industrial Services, Inc. as the lowest responsive and responsible bidder to
42 perform the work on the Project; and

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44 WHEREAS, the Board of Control, at its meeting held on December 8, 2021, awarded a
45 construction contract with Workman Industrial Services, Inc. for the Project, in an amount not to
46 exceed \$252,366.00; and

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48 WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information,
49 that the aforementioned construction contract with Workman Industrial Services, Inc. is
50 necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit;

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4 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State
5 of Ohio, that;

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7 SECTION 1

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9 The award by the Board of Control of a construction contract with Workman Industrial
10 Services, Inc. for the Miscellaneous Bridge/Culvert Repair Project to repair bridges and culverts
11 in Council Districts 1, 6 and 7, in an amount not to exceed \$252,366.00, is hereby confirmed and
12 the Executive is hereby authorized to execute said construction contract and any other necessary
13 related documents.

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15 SECTION 2

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17 This Resolution is declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety, and welfare
18 of the residents of the County of Summit, and for the further reason that it immediately provides
19 for necessary improvements to the County's culverts in Council Districts 1, 6 and 7.

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21 SECTION 3

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23 Provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of eight members, it shall take
24 effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Executive; otherwise, it shall take
25 effect and be in force at the earliest time provided by law.

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27 SECTION 4

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29 It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating
30 to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all
31 deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were
32 in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section
33 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.


