7 **A Resolution confirming the award by the Board of Control for an extension of a**
8 **professional services contract with Oriana House, Inc. for community corrections services,**
9 **which shall include the operation of the County of Summit Community Alternative**
10 **Sentencing Center (CS-CASC), for a one-year term, from 1/1/22 through 12/31/22, in an**
11 **amount not to exceed \$6,946,915.68, for the Executive's Department of Public Safety and**
12 **declaring an emergency.**

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14 WHEREAS, this Council previously adopted Resolution No. 2016-433, which confirmed
15 the award by the Board of Control of a professional services contract with Oriana House, Inc. for
16 day reporting, driver intervention, home incarceration, multiple offender, pretrial services and
17 residential community corrections programs for the period 1/1/17 through 12/31/17, in an
18 amount not to exceed \$5,921,097.39, with four options to renew for an additional one-year
19 term, with the cost of any renewal term to be equal to the increase in the Consumer Price
20 Index or three percent, whichever is less; and

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22 WHEREAS, this Council subsequently adopted Resolution No. 2018-026, which
23 confirmed the award by the Board of Control for a renewal (first of four) of a professional
24 services contract with Oriana House, Inc. for community corrections services, for a one-year
25 term from 1/1/18 through 12/31/18, in an amount not to exceed \$5,921,097.39; and

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27 WHEREAS, this Council subsequently adopted Resolution No. 2018-360, which
28 repealed Ordinance No. 83-406 and 96-611 designating 40 East Glenwood Avenue, Akron,
29 Ohio 44304 as a County Jail Facility and pursuant to Section 307.932 of the Ohio Revised
30 Code redesignated and established 40 East Glenwood Avenue as the County of Summit
31 Community Alternative Sentencing Center (CA-CASC); and

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33 WHEREAS, this Council subsequently adopted Resolution No. 2018-359, which
34 authorized the Executive to execute, subject to the approval of the Board of Control, a renewal
35 (second of four) of a professional services contract with Oriana House, Inc. for community
36 corrections services, which included the operation of the CS-CASC, for a one-year term from
37 1/1/19 through 12/31/19, in an amount not to exceed \$6,571,493.73; and

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39 WHEREAS, this Council subsequently adopted Resolution No. 2020-051, which
40 confirmed the award by the Board of Control for a renewal (third of four) of a professional
41 services contract with Oriana House, Inc. for community corrections services, which included
42 the operation of the CS-CASC, for a one-year term from 1/1/20 through 12/31/20, in an amount
43 not to exceed \$6,946,915.68; and

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45 WHEREAS, this Council subsequently adopted Resolution No. 2021-005, which
46 confirmed the award by the Board of Control for a final renewal (four of four) of a professional
47 services contract with Oriana House, Inc. for community corrections services, which included
48 the operation of the CS-CASC, for a one-year term from 1/1/21 through 12/31/21, in an amount
49 not to exceed \$6,946,915.68; and

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4 WHEREAS, the County is in the process of implementing various technology projects to
5 assist in creating and improving efficiencies throughout the criminal justice system; and
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7 WHEREAS, due to the pending technology outcomes for the criminal justice system, the
8 Executive wishes to extend the current professional services agreement with Oriana House, Inc.
9 for community corrections services, which shall continue to include the operation of the CS-
10 CASC for a one-year term, from 1/1/22 through 12/31/22; and
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12 WHEREAS, the Board of Control, at its meeting held January 19, 2022, awarded the
13 aforementioned professional services contract with Oriana House, Inc. for community
14 corrections program services, including the operation of the CS-CASC, subject to the
15 confirmation by this Council; and
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17 WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information,
18 that the aforementioned extension of the professional services contract with Oriana House, Inc.,
19 which shall include the operation of the CS-CASC, is necessary and in the best interest of the
20 County of Summit.
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22 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State
23 of Ohio, that;

27 The award by the Board of Control for an extension of a professional services contract
28 with Oriana House, Inc. for community corrections services, which shall include the operation of
29 the County of Summit Community Alternative Sentencing Center (CS-CASC), for a one-year
30 term, from 1/1/22 through 12/31/22, in an amount not to exceed \$6,946,915.68 is hereby
31 approved and the Executive is authorized to execute said professional services contract and any
32 other necessary related documents.
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34 SECTION 2

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36 This Resolution is declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety, and welfare
37 of the residents of the County of Summit, and for the further reason that it authorizes the
38 Executive to continue to contract for community corrections services.
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40 SECTION 3

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42 Provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of eight members, it shall take
43 effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Executive; otherwise, it shall take
44 effect and be in force at the earliest time provided by law.
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46 SECTION 4

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48 It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating
49 to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all
50 deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were
51 in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section
52 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.


