7 **A Resolution confirming the award by the Board of Control of a Temporary Assistance to**
8 **Needy Families Agreement with the Summit County Combined General Health District**
9 **dba Summit County Public Health, to provide diaper bank services, from 3/1/22 through**
10 **12/31/22, in an amount not to exceed \$80,000.00, for the Executive’s Department of Job and**
11 **Family Services, and declaring an emergency.**

13 WHEREAS, the Executive’s Department of Jobs and Family Services (“DJFS”) seeks to
14 enter into a Temporary Assistance to Needy Families (“TANF”) agreement with the Summit
15 County Combined General Health District dba Summit County Public Health (“SCPH”) to
16 provide diaper bank services; and

17
18 WHEREAS, under this proposed agreement, SCPH will coordinate a county-wide diaper
19 bank for distribution of diapers, wipes and pull-ups to TANF eligible individuals, in
20 collaboration with DJFS and the Full Term First Birthday local collaborative; and

21
22 WHEREAS, SCHP will also distribute diapers, child safety items, parenting essentials
23 and related information at community resource fairs in Summit County for pregnant women and
24 parents known as Community Baby Showers; and

26 WHEREAS, this Council previously adopted Resolution No. 2021-206, which confirmed
27 the award by the Board of Control of a similar TANF agreement with SCPH for said services in
28 2021; and

30 WHEREAS, the Executive wishes to enter into a new TANF Agreement with SCPH to
31 provide the above referenced services in 2022; and

33 WHEREAS, the Board of Control, at its meeting held on February 2, 2022, awarded a
34 TANF Agreement with SCPH, which is exempt from competitive bidding due to the provider’s
35 subgrantee status, to provide diaper bank services, from 3/1/22 through 12/31/22, in an amount
36 not to exceed \$80,000.00, subject to confirmation by this Council; and

38 WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information,
39 that the aforementioned TANF Agreement with SCPH is necessary and in the best interest of the
40 County of Summit;

42 NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State
43 of Ohio, that:

47 The award by the Board of Control of a Temporary Assistance to Needy Families
48 (“TANF”) Agreement with Summit County Combined General Health District dba Summit
49 County Public Health (“SCPH”) to provide diaper bank services, from 3/1/22 through 12/31/22,
50 in an amount not to exceed \$80,000.00, is hereby confirmed and the Executive is hereby
51 authorized to execute said agreement and any other necessary related documents.

13 effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Executive; otherwise, it shall take
14 effect and be in force at the earliest time provided by law.

19 to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all
20 deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action,

22 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.


