7 **A Resolution confirming the award by the Board of Control of a Temporary Assistance to**
8 **Needy Families Agreement with Emmanuel Christian Academy for Entrepreneurship**
9 **Summer Camp Services, from 5/1/22 through 9/30/22, in an amount not to exceed**
10 **\$100,000.00, for the Executive's Department of Job and Family Services, and declaring an**
11 **emergency.**

13 WHEREAS, this Council previously adopted 2021-205, which amended a Temporary
14 Assistance to Needy Families ("TANF") Agreement with Emmanuel Christian Academy for
15 Entrepreneurship Summer Camp Services, from 5/1/21 through 8/30/21, to increase the total not
16 to exceed amount to \$128,225.24; and

17
18 WHEREAS, pursuant to the TANF Agreement, Emmanuel Christian Academy provided
19 entrepreneurship summer camp services which introduce students to self-sufficiency though
20 development of business opportunities and life skills; and

21
22 WHEREAS, the services are offered to youth aged 9 to 15 years old via classroom
23 workshops, guest speakers, group projects and field trips; and cover a range of training topics;
24 and

26 WHEREAS, due to the success of the program, the Executive wishes to enter into a new
27 TANF Agreement with Emmanuel Christian Academy to provide the above referenced services
28 from 5/1/22 through 9/30/22, in an amount not to exceed \$100,000.00; and

30 WHEREAS, the Board of Control, at its meeting held February 2, 2022, awarded a
31 TANF Agreement with Emmanuel Christian Academy, which is exempt from competitive
32 bidding due to the provider's subgrantee status, for Entrepreneurship Summer Camp Services,
33 from 5/1/22 through 9/30/22, in an amount not to exceed \$100,000.00, subject to the approval of
34 this Council; and

36 WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information,
37 that it is necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit to authorize the Executive, to
38 execute the aforementioned TANF Agreement with Emmanuel Christian Academy;

40 NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State
41 of Ohio, that:

45 The award by the Board of Control, of a Temporary Assistance to Needy Families
46 ("TANF") Agreement with Emmanuel Christian Academy to provide for Entrepreneurship
47 Summer Camp Services, from 5/1/22 through 9/30/22, in an amount not to exceed \$100,000.00,
48 is hereby confirmed and the Executive is hereby authorized to execute said agreement and any
49 other necessary documents.

23 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.


