7 **A Resolution confirming the award by the Board of Control of a renewal (second of four)**
8 **of a professional service contract with Sadler-NeCamp Financial Services, Inc. dba**
9 **Proware, as a Best Practical Source, for case management system software support and**
10 **maintenance services, for a one-year term, from 1/1/22 through 12/31/22, for an amount not**
11 **to exceed \$200,280.00, for the Court of Common Pleas-General Division, and declaring an**
12 **emergency.**

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14 WHEREAS, the Court of Common Pleas-General Division (the "Court") utilizes
15 proprietary case management software purchased from Sadler-NeCamp Financial Services, Inc.
16 dba Proware ("Proware"); and

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18 WHEREAS, Proware is a Best Practical Source pursuant to Sections 177.01(h)(4)D. and
19 177.07(a)(5) of the Codified Ordinances of the County of Summit because the case management
20 system software support and maintenance services provided are for a proprietary system already
21 being utilized by the Court; and

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23 WHEREAS, this Council previously adopted Resolution No. 2020-121, which confirmed
24 the award by the Board of Control of a professional service contract with Proware, as a Sole
25 Source, subject to the approval of the Information Technology Board, for case management
26 system software support and maintenance services, for a one-year term, from 1/1/20 through
27 12/31/20, for an amount not to exceed \$191,440.00 for the first year, with four options to renew
28 for an additional one-year term, for a total cost not to exceed \$999,540.00 for the five-year
29 period; and

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31 WHEREAS, this Council previously adopted Resolution No. 2021-036, which confirmed
32 the award by the Board of Control of the first renewal of said professional service contract with
33 Proware, as a Sole Source, for a one-year term, from 1/1/21 through 12/31/21, for an amount not
34 to exceed \$195,815.00; and

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36 WHEREAS, the Board of Control, at its meeting held February 2, 2022, awarded a
37 second renewal of said professional service contract with Proware, as a Best Practical Source, for
38 a one-year term, from 1/1/22 through 12/31/22, for an amount not to exceed \$200,280.00; and

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40 WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines after reviewing all pertinent information,
41 that the aforementioned second renewal of a professional service contract with Sadler-NeCamp
42 Financial Services, Inc. dba Proware is necessary and in the best interest of the County of
43 Summit;

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45 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State
46 of Ohio, that:

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50 The award by the Board of Control of a renewal (second of four) of a professional service
51 contract with Sadler-NeCamp Financial Services, Inc. dba Proware ("Proware"), as a Best

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6 one-year term, from 1/1/22 through 12/31/22, for an amount not to exceed \$200,280.00, is
7 hereby confirmed and the Executive is hereby authorized to execute said professional service
8 contract and any other necessary related documents.

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12 This Resolution is hereby declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety and
13 welfare of the residents of the County of Summit, and for the further reason to immediately
14 provide for the aforementioned case management system software support and maintenance
15 services by Proware effective 1/1/22.

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19 Provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of eight members, it shall take
20 effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Executive; otherwise, it shall take
21 effect and be in force at the earliest time provided by law.

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23 SECTION 4

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25 It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating
26 to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all
27 deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action,
28 were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section
