7 **A Resolution confirming the award by the Board of Control of a construction contract with**
8 **Barbicas Construction Company, Inc. for the 2022 Summit County 441 Asphalt Concrete**
9 **(448) Resurfacing Program-North, in an amount not to exceed \$2,930,214.50, for the**
10 **Engineer, and declaring an emergency.**

12 WHEREAS, this Council previously adopted Resolution No. 2021-388, which authorized
13 the Executive to advertise, as needed, for bridge engineering and construction projects, and
14 pavement maintenance projects, for the Engineer's 2022 Capital Improvements Program, and
15 federal and state funded projects, for an estimated total cost not to exceed \$12,724,400.00; and

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17 WHEREAS, said projects were approved as part of the Capital Improvements Program
18 for 2022-2027 by Resolution No. 2022-032; and

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20 WHEREAS, following the receipt and review of bids, the Executive has proposed
21 entering into a construction contract with Barbicas Construction Company, Inc. for the 2022
22 Summit County 441 Asphalt Concrete (448) Resurfacing Program-North, in an amount not to
23 exceed \$2,930,214.50; and

25 WHEREAS, the work to be performed by Barbicas Construction Company, Inc. will
26 consist of resurfacing various County, Bath Township, Richfield Township, Sagamore Hills
27 Township and Twinsburg Township roads, including milling, pavement repairs, chip seal prior to
28 resurfacing, an asphalt concrete surface course and new pavement markings; and

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30 WHEREAS, the contract total will be broken down by political subdivision as follows
31 with each subdivision responsible for directly paying the contractor:

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33 County (Including Revere Road alternate): \$1,386,517.35
34 Bath Township: \$292,011.00
35 Richfield Township: \$204,930.00
36 Sagamore Hills Township: \$390,069.15
37 Sagamore Hills Alternate No. 2: \$144,873.20
38 Sagamore Hills Alternate No. 3: \$148,672.80
39 Sagamore Hills Alternate No. 4: \$164,374.40
40 Twinsburg Township: \$178,583.00
41 Twinsburg Township Alternate No. 6: \$30,183.60; and

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43 WHEREAS, the Board of Control, at its meeting held on March 16, 2022, awarded a
44 construction contract with Barbicas Construction Company, Inc., as a Disadvantaged Local
45 Business Preference under Section 177.03 of the Codified Ordinances of the County of Summit,
46 for the 2022 Summit County 441 Asphalt Concrete (448) Resurfacing Program-North, in an
47 amount not to exceed \$2,930,214.50, subject to confirmation by this Council; and

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49 WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information,
50 that the aforementioned construction contract with Barbicas Construction Company, Inc. for the

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4 2022 Summit County 441 Asphalt Concrete (448) Resurfacing Program-North is necessary and
5 in the best interest of the County of Summit;

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7 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State
8 of Ohio, that;

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10 SECTION 1

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12 The award by the Board of Control of a construction contract with Barbicas Construction
13 Company, Inc. for the 2022 Summit County 441 Asphalt Concrete (448) Resurfacing Program-
14 North, in an amount not to exceed \$2,930,214.50, is hereby confirmed and the Executive is
15 hereby authorized to execute said construction contract and any other necessary related
16 documents.

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18 SECTION 2

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20 This Resolution is hereby declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety and
21 welfare of the residents of the County of Summit, and for the further purpose to immediately
22 provide necessary pavement repairs to various County, Bath Township, Sagamore Hills
23 Township, Richfield Township, and Twinsburg Township roads in 2022.

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25 SECTION 3

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27 Provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of eight members, it shall take
28 effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Executive; otherwise, it shall take
29 effect and be in force at the earliest time provided by law.

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31 SECTION 4

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33 It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating
34 to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all
35 deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action,
36 were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section
37 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.


