7 **A Resolution confirming the award by the Board of Control, subject to the approval of the**
8 **Information Technology Board, of a purchase contract with Offender Smartphone**
9 **Monitoring LLC dba Outreach Smartphone Monitoring, as a Best Practical Source, for**
10 **software and support services for remote supervision of felony offenders on probation, for**
11 **a two-year term, from 3/1/22 through 2/28/24, for an amount not to exceed \$150,000.00, for**
12 **the Court of Common Pleas-General Division-Adult Probation Department, and declaring**
13 **an emergency.**

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15 WHEREAS, the COVID-19 pandemic is a health crisis that requires the Court of
16 Common Pleas-General Division-Adult Probation Department to change its method of
17 supervision of felony offenders on probation; and

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19 WHEREAS, due to the COVID-19 pandemic, Adult Probation sought to utilize
20 smartphone technology to assist in monitoring felony offenders on probation remotely; and

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22 WHEREAS, in order to utilize such technology, the Court of Common Pleas-General
23 Division recommended that the Executive enter into a professional service contract with
24 Offender Smartphone Monitoring LLC dba Outreach Smartphone Monitoring (“OSM”), for
25 software and support services for remote supervision of felony offenders on probation, for a one-
26 year term, for amount not to exceed \$146,000.00; and

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28 WHEREAS, this Council subsequently adopted Resolution No. 2020-144, which
29 confirmed the award of said professional service contract with OSM for a one-year term, for
30 amount not to exceed \$146,000.00; and

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32 WHEREAS, by Change Order, the agreement was extended to 21 months, from 6/1/20
33 through 2/28/22; and

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35 WHEREAS, the Court of Common Pleas-General Division recommends that the
36 Executive continue the program and enter into a purchase contract with OSM for software and
37 support services for remote supervision of felony offenders on probation, for a two-year term,
38 from 3/1/22 through 2/28/24, for an amount not to exceed \$150,000.00; and

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40 WHEREAS, OSM is a Best Practical Source pursuant to Sections 177.01(h)(4)D. and
41 177.07(a)(5) of the Codified Ordinances of the County of Summit because the technology
42 offered by OSM has served a central role in allowing the Adult Probation Department to provide
43 supervision and closely monitor offenders during the pandemic and will provide valuable tools to
44 the Department should the pandemic continue; and

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46 WHEREAS, the Board of Control, at its meeting held on March 16, 2022, awarded,
47 subject to the approval of the Information Technology Board, said purchase contract with OSM,
48 as a Best Practical Source, subject to confirmation by this Council; and

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50 WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information,
51 that the aforementioned professional service contract with OSM is necessary and in the best
52 interest of the County of Summit;

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4 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State
5 of Ohio, that;

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7 SECTION 1

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9 The award by the Board of Control, subject to the approval of the Information
10 Technology Board, of a professional service contract with Offender Smartphone Monitoring
11 LLC dba Outreach Smartphone Monitoring, as a Best Practical Source, for software and support
12 services for remote supervision of felony offenders on probation, for a two-year term, from
13 3/1/22 through 2/28/24, for an amount not to exceed \$150,000.000, is hereby confirmed and the
14 Executive is hereby authorized to execute said professional service contract and any other
15 necessary related documents.

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17 SECTION 2

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19 This Resolution is hereby declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety, and
20 welfare of the residents of the County of Summit, and for the further reason to immediately
21 continue a necessary contract for the remote monitoring of felony offenders by the Adult
22 Probation Department during the COVID-19 pandemic.

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24 SECTION 3

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26 Provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of eight members, it shall take
27 effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Executive; otherwise, it shall take
28 effect and be in force at the earliest time provided by law.

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30 SECTION 4

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32 It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating
33 to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all
34 deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action,
35 were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section
36 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
