7 **A Resolution authorizing the Executive to execute a Cooperative Agreement with the City**  
8 **of Fairlawn for the resurfacing of Cleveland-Massillon Road, located in the City of**  
9 **Fairlawn, Bath Township and Copley Township, in Council District 5, for the Engineer,**  
10 **and declaring an emergency.**

11  
12 WHEREAS, the Engineer and the City of Fairlawn have determined Cleveland-Massillon  
13 Road from Ridgewood Road to Ghent Road, located in the City of Fairlawn, Copley Township,  
14 and Bath Township, requires resurfacing (the "Project"); and

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16 WHEREAS, the City of Fairlawn has secured federal Surface Transportation Block Grant  
17 funds in the amount of \$787,500.00 for the construction of the Project; and

18  
19 WHEREAS, the Project is approximately 1.27 miles long with 37% of the paved surface  
20 in the City of Fairlawn and 63% of the paved surface in Bath Township and Copley Township;  
21 and

23 WHEREAS, it is necessary for the parties to enter into a Cooperative Agreement to set  
24 forth the rights and duties of the parties concerning the design and construction of the Project, a  
25 copy of said agreement is attached hereto as Exhibit A and incorporated fully herein; and

27 WHEREAS, the Project is estimated to cost \$1,262,359.00, with grant funds covering  
28 \$787,500.00, City of Fairlawn funds covering \$175,698.00, and County funds covering  
29 \$299,161.00; and

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31 WHEREAS, the City of Fairlawn will administer the Project; and

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33 WHEREAS, this Council has determined by reviewing all pertinent information that it is  
34 necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit to authorize the Executive to execute  
35 a Cooperative Agreement with the City of Fairlawn for the aforementioned Project;

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37 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State  
38 of Ohio, that;

40 SECTION 1

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42 The Executive is hereby authorized to execute a Cooperative Agreement with the City of  
43 Fairlawn for the resurfacing of Cleveland-Massillon Road from Ridgewood Road to Ghent Road  
44 (the "Project"), located in the City of Fairlawn, Copley Township, and Bath Township, in  
45 Council District 5, pursuant to which the City of Fairlawn will provide funds in the amount of  
46 \$175,698.00 and County will provide funds in the amount of \$299,161.00, with federal Surface  
47 Transportation Block Grant funds in the amount of \$787,500.00 providing the remainder of the  
48 estimated cost of \$1,262,359.00. A copy of said agreement is attached hereto as Exhibit A and  
49 incorporated fully herein, with such modifications and revisions as shall be in furtherance of the  
50 provisions of said Cooperative Agreement and not substantially adverse to the County, all of

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6 which shall be conclusively evidenced by the execution thereof by the Executive.

8 SECTION 2

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10 This Resolution is hereby declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety and  
11 welfare of the residents of the County of Summit, and for the further purpose to immediately  
12 allow the Executive to execute said agreement and allow the City of Fairlawn and the County to  
13 proceed with a needed road improvement.

15 SECTION 3


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17 Provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of eight members, it shall take  
18 effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Executive; otherwise, it shall take  
19 effect and be in force at the earliest time provided by law.

21 SECTION 4

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23 It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating  
24 to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all  
25 deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action,  
26 were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section  
27 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.


