7 **A Resolution confirming the award by the Board of Control of a construction contract with**
8 **Melway Paving Company, Inc., for the 2022 Summit County 422 Resurfacing Program, in**
9 **an amount not to exceed \$875,020.25, for the Engineer, and declaring an emergency.**

11 WHEREAS, this Council previously adopted Resolution No. 2021-388, which authorized
12 the Executive to advertise, as needed, for bridge engineering and construction projects, and
13 pavement maintenance projects, for the Engineer's 2022 Capital Improvements Program, and
14 federal and state funded projects, for an estimated total cost not to exceed \$12,724,400.00; and

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16 WHEREAS, said projects were approved as part of the Capital Improvements Program
17 for 2022-2027 by Resolution No. 2022-032; and

19 WHEREAS, following the receipt and review of bids, the Executive proposes entering
20 into a construction contract with Melway Paving Company, Inc., for the 2022 Summit County
21 405 Resurfacing Program, in an amount not to exceed \$875,020.25; and

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23 WHEREAS, the work to be performed by Melway Paving Company, Inc. will consist of
24 resurfacing various County, Bath Township, Copley Township, Coventry Township, New
25 Franklin Township and Springfield Township roads, by applying 422 Chip Seal; and

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27 WHEREAS, the contract total will be broken down by political subdivision as follows
28 with each subdivision responsible for directly paying the contractor:

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30 County: \$300,965.40
31 Bath Township: \$39,022.00
32 Copley Township: \$68,894.00
33 Copley Township Alternate No. 2: \$30,058.85
34 Copley Township Alternate No. 3: \$7,786.50
35 Copley Township Alternate No. 4: \$16,574.25
36 Copley Township Alternate No. 4: \$16,274.25
37 Coventry Township: \$104,607.50
38 New Franklin: \$216,067.50
39 Springfield Township: \$74,770.00; and

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41 WHEREAS, following the receipt and review of bids, the Executive proposes entering
42 into a construction contract with Melway Paving Company, Inc., for the 2021 Summit County
43 422 Resurfacing Program, in an amount not to exceed \$875,020.25; and

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45 WHEREAS, the Board of Control, at its meeting held on March 23, 2022, awarded a
46 construction contract with Melway Paving Company, Inc., as the lowest responsive and
47 responsible bidder, for the 2022 Summit County 422 Resurfacing Program, in an amount not to
48 exceed \$875,020.25, subject to confirmation by this Council; and

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4 WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information,
5 that the aforementioned construction contract with Melway Paving Company, Inc. is necessary
6 and in the best interest of the County of Summit;

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8 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State
9 of Ohio, that;

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11 SECTION 1

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13 The award by the Board of Control of a construction contract with Melway Paving
14 Company, Inc., for the 2022 Summit County 422 Resurfacing Program, in an amount not to
15 exceed \$875,020.25, is hereby confirmed and the Executive is hereby authorized to execute said
16 construction contract and any other necessary related documents.

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18 SECTION 2

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20 This Resolution is hereby declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety and
21 welfare of the residents of the County of Summit, and for the further purpose to immediately
22 providing a necessary construction contract for the 2022 Summit County 422 Resurfacing
23 Program.

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25 SECTION 3

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27 Provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of eight members, it shall take
28 effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Executive; otherwise, it shall take
29 effect and be in force at the earliest time provided by law.

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31 SECTION 4

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33 It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating
34 to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all
35 deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action,
36 were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section
37 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
