A Resolution confirming the award by the Board of Control of Change Order No. 1 to a professional service contract with Burgess & Niple, Inc. for engineering design and surveying services for the Hines Hill Trunk Sewer Replacement Project Q-169, located in the Village of Boston Heights, in Council Districts 1 and 3, in an amount not to exceed \$176,400.00 (for a cumulative increase of 38.6%), for a total amount not to exceed \$633,651.00, for the Executive's Department of Sanitary Sewer Services, and declaring an emergency.

WHEREAS, the Hines Hill Trunk Sewer, which is located in the Village of Boston Heights, in Council Districts 1 and 3, was originally constructed in 1970 and as a result of development activities in the service area, there will be additional users of the current trunk sewer; and

WHEREAS, the Executive's Department of Sanitary Sewer Services has determined that the aforementioned trunk sewer only has sufficient capacity to meet flows generated by existing users and a replacement is necessary; and

WHEREAS, the Hines Hill Trunk Sewer Replacement Project Q-169 (the "Project") is intended to provide sufficient capacity to address current pipe/system conditions, as well as accommodate continued planned development in the service area; and

WHEREAS, this Council previously adopted Resolution No. 2018-038, which confirmed the award by the Board of Control of a professional service contract with Burgess & Niple, Inc. for engineering design and surveying services for the Project, in an amount not to exceed \$457,251.00; and

WHEREAS, the scope of the Project has been revised to reroute the trunk sewer through two pump stations and abandon the existing sewer through wetlands, resulting in additional costs to complete design services for the Project; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Control, at its meeting held March 30, 2022, awarded Change Order No. 1 to the professional service contract with Burgess & Niple, Inc. for engineering design and surveying services for the Project, in an amount not to exceed \$176,400.00 (for a cumulative increase of 38.6%), for a total amount not to exceed \$633,651.00, subject to confirmation by this Council; and

WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information, that Change Order No. 1 to the aforementioned professional service contract with Burgess & Niple, Inc. is necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit;
