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7 **A Resolution confirming the award by the Board of Control of a professional service**
8 **contract with Oriana House, Inc., as a Best Practical Source, for community corrections**
9 **services, for the period 7/1/21 through 6/30/23, in an amount not to exceed \$1,700,000.00,**
10 **for the Executive's Department of Public Safety, and declaring an emergency.**

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12 WHEREAS, the Ohio Department of Rehabilitation and Corrections ("ODRC") awarded
13 Summit County a Targeted Community Alternatives to Prison ("TCAP") Grant to enhance
14 programming and supervision alternatives to be able to maintain Felony 4 & 5 offenders locally,
15 in lieu of prison; and

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17 WHEREAS, this includes expanding the number of eligible clients and the scope of
18 programming provided through the current community corrections CCA 407 and 408 and
19 general fund contracts with Oriana House, Inc. Programs will include employment services,
20 GED and literacy services and additional cognitive skills services; and

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22 WHEREAS, Oriana House, Inc. is a Best Practical Source pursuant to Sections
23 177.01(h)(4)D. and 177.07(a)(5) of the Codified Ordinances of the County of Summit as they
24 currently provide similar community corrections services under the Community Corrections Act
25 grant 407 and 408 contracts previously adopted by this Council (Resolution Nos. 2021-219 and
26 2021-220, respectively), as well as the general fund, which was subject to the Request for
27 Proposal process; and

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29 WHEREAS, the Board of Control, at its meeting held April 6, 2022, awarded a
30 professional service contract with Oriana House, Inc., as a Best Practical Source, for community
31 corrections services, for the period 7/1/21 through 6/30/23, in an amount not to exceed
32 \$1,700,000.00, subject to confirmation by this Council; and

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34 WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines after reviewing all pertinent information,
35 that the aforementioned professional service contract with Oriana House, Inc. is necessary and in
36 the best interest of the County of Summit;

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38 NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State
39 of Ohio, that:

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43 The award by the Board of Control of a professional service contract with Oriana House,
44 Inc., as a Best Practical Source, for community corrections services, for the period 7/1/21
45 through 6/30/23, in an amount not to exceed \$1,700,000.00 is hereby confirmed and the
46 Executive is hereby authorized to execute said professional service contract and any necessary
47 related documents.

20 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.


