SECTION 1		
Section 521.10 of the Codified Ordinances of the County of Summit, entitled "Noxious Weeds and Rank Vegetation," is hereby amended as set forth on Exhibit A, attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference.		
SECTION 2		
This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency in the interest of the health, safety and welfare of the residents of the County of Summit and to immediately benefit the habitats of pollinating insects in the County.
