7 **A Resolution confirming the award by the Board of Control of a construction contract with**
8 **American Roadway Logistics for the 2022 Regional Pavement Marking Program, in an**
9 **amount not to exceed \$320,752.05, for the Engineer, and declaring an emergency.**

11 WHEREAS, this Council previously adopted Resolution No. 2021-388, which authorized
12 the Executive to advertise, as needed, for bridge engineering and construction projects, and
13 pavement maintenance projects, for the Engineer's 2022 Capital Improvements Program, and
14 federal and state funded projects, for an estimated total cost not to exceed \$12,724,400.00; and

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16 WHEREAS, said projects were approved as part of the Capital Improvements Program
17 for 2022-2027 by Resolution No. 2022-032; and

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19 WHEREAS, following the receipt and review of bids, the Executive proposes entering
20 into a construction contract with American Roadway Logistics, as the lowest responsive and
21 responsible bidder, for the 2022 Regional Pavement Marking Program, in an amount not to
22 exceed \$320,752.05; and

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24 WHEREAS, the work to be performed by American Roadway Logistics will be applying
25 pavement marking paint to various County, Copley Township, City of New Franklin, Sagamore
26 Hills Township, Twinsburg Township and Summit MetroParks roads; and

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28 WHEREAS, the contract total will be broken down by political subdivision as follows
29 with each subdivision responsible for directly paying the contractor:

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31 County share: \$222,227.05
32 Copley: \$9,485.40
33 New Franklin: \$34,926.15
34 Sagamore Hills: \$6,145.95
35 Twinsburg Twp.: \$14,985.85
36 MetroParks: \$22,775.65
37 MetroParks Alternate: \$10,206.00; and

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39 WHEREAS, the Board of Control, at its meeting held on April 20, 2022, awarded a
40 construction contract with American Roadway Logistics, as the lowest responsive and
41 responsible bidder, for the 2022 Regional Pavement Marking Program, in an amount not to
42 exceed \$320,752.05, subject to confirmation by this Council; and

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44 WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information,
45 that the aforementioned construction contract with American Roadway Logistics for the 2022
46 Regional Pavement Marking Program is necessary and in the best interest of the County of
47 Summit;

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49 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State

6 The award by the Board of Control of a construction contract with American Roadway
7 Logistics for the 2022 Regional Pavement Marking Program, in an amount not to exceed
8 \$320,752.05, is hereby confirmed and the Executive is hereby authorized to execute said
9 construction contract and any other necessary related documents.

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11 SECTION 2

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13 This Resolution is hereby declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety and
14 welfare of the residents of the County of Summit, and for the further purpose to immediately
15 provide necessary pavement marking to various County, Copley Township, City of New
16 Franklin, Sagamore Hills Township, Twinsburg Township and Summit MetroParks roads in
17 2022.

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19 SECTION 3

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21 Provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of eight members, it shall take
22 effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Executive; otherwise, it shall take
23 effect and be in force at the earliest time provided by law.

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25 SECTION 4

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27 It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating
28 to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all
29 deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action,
30 were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section
31 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.


