WHEREAS, the Executive subsequently determined that S.A. Comunale Co. Inc. has a State Term contract that would permit S.A. Comunale Co. Inc. to perform the work; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Control, at its meeting held on April 13, 2022, awarded a construction contract with S.A. Comunale Co. Inc., at State Term Pricing, for the fire suppression component for the Combined Dispatch Building Project, located in the City of Tallmadge, in Council District 6, in an amount not to exceed \$415,100.00, subject to confirmation by this Council; and

The award by the Board of Control of a construction contract with S.A. Comunale Co. Inc., at State Term Pricing, for the fire suppression component for the Combined Dispatch Building Project (the "Project"), located in the City of Tallmadge, in Council District 6, in an amount not to exceed \$415,100.00, is hereby confirmed and the Executive is hereby authorized to execute said construction contract and any other necessary related documents.

SECTION 2

This Council hereby makes the following declaration of official intent under United States Treasury Regulations for purposes of Sections 103 and 141 to 150 of the Internal Revenue code of 1986 (the "Internal Revenue Code"): This Council declares, on behalf of the County, that it reasonably expects the expenditures related to the construction of the Combined Regional Dispatch Center will be reimbursed with the proceeds of bonds (as defined in Section 150 of the Internal Revenue Code). The maximum principal amount of bonds expected to be issued for the purpose described in this Section 2 is not to exceed \$20,000,000.00.

SECTION 3

This Resolution is declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety, and welfare of the residents of the County of Summit, and for the further reason that it authorizes the Executive to immediately provide for construction of the necessary fire suppression component for the Project.
