7 **A Resolution confirming the award by the Board of Control of a Temporary Assistance to**
8 **Needy Families Agreement with Akron Community Service Center & Urban League, Inc.,**
9 **to provide Science, Technology, Engineering, Arts and Math (STEAM) Program services,**
10 **from 7/1/22 through 6/30/23, in an amount not to exceed \$75,000.00, for the Executive's**
11 **Department of Job and Family Services, and declaring an emergency.**

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13 WHEREAS, the Executive's Department of Jobs and Family Services ("DJFS"), in 2021,
14 entered into a Temporary Assistance to Needy Families ("TANF") agreement with Akron
15 Community Service Center & Urban League, Inc., to provide Science, Technology, Engineering,
16 Arts and Math (STEAM) Program services as authorized by this Council in Resolution No.
17 2021-207, to continue the STEAM services Akron Community Service Center & Urban League,
18 Inc., has provided for DJFS since 2017; and

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20 WHEREAS, the Executive wishes to enter into a new agreement with Akron Community
21 Service Center & Urban League, Inc., for STEAM Program services for students in 3rd through
22 6th grades. The program services will be offered in an afterschool classroom setting designed to
23 enhance STEAM interest and aptitudes, utilizing the STEM NASA curriculum model; and

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25 WHEREAS, the STEAM Program services will include homework assistance, student
26 engagement, student learning benchmark development and achievement, experiential learning,
27 development of Individual Educational Programs for each student and parent meetings; and

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29 WHEREAS, the Board of Control, at its meeting held May 4, 2022, awarded a TANF
30 Agreement with Akron Community Service Center & Urban League, Inc., which is exempt from
31 competitive bidding due to the provider's subgrantee status, to provide Science, Technology,
32 Engineering, Arts and Math (STEAM) Program services, from 7/1/22 through 6/30/23, in an
33 amount not to exceed \$75,000.00, subject to confirmation by this Council; and

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35 WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information,
36 that the aforementioned TANF Agreement with Akron Community Service Center & Urban
37 League, Inc. is necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit;

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39 NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State
40 of Ohio, that:

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42 SECTION 1

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44 The award by the Board of Control of a Temporary Assistance to Needy Families
45 ("TANF") Agreement with Akron Community Service Center & Urban League, Inc., to provide
46 Science, Technology, Engineering, Arts and Math (STEAM) Program services, from 7/1/22
47 through 6/30/23, in an amount not to exceed \$75,000.00, is hereby confirmed and the Executive
48 is hereby authorized to execute said agreement and any necessary related documents.

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6 This Resolution is hereby declared an emergency in the interest of health, safety, and
7 welfare of the residents of the County of Summit, and for the further reason to provide STEAM
8 Program services beginning on 7/1/22.

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12 Provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of eight members, it shall take
13 effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Executive; otherwise, it shall take
14 effect and be in force at the earliest time provided by law.

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18 It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating
19 to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all
20 deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action,
21 were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section
22 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.


