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7 **A Resolution confirming the award by the Board of Control of Change Order No. 1 to a**
8 **Temporary Assistance to Needy Families Agreement with Greenleaf Family Center, to**
9 **provide child safety education services and to distribute child safety and basic needs items,**
10 **to pregnant women and parents of young children, from 7/1/21 through 9/30/22, in an**
11 **amount not to exceed \$103,300.00 (for a cumulative increase of 41.32%), for a total amount**
12 **not to exceed \$353,300.00, for the Executive’s Department of Job and Family Services, and**
13 **declaring an emergency.**

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15 WHEREAS, this Council previously adopted Resolution No. 2021-167, which confirmed
16 the award by the Board of Control of a Temporary Assistance to Needy Families (“TANF”)
17 Agreement with Greenleaf Family Center to provide child safety education services and to
18 distribute child safety and basic needs items, to pregnant women and parents of young children;
19 and

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21 WHEREAS, the provided education services include basic safety awareness and
22 instructions, along with resource and referral information regarding child safety and basic
23 parenting needs. Child safety and basic needs items include the most requested and needed items
24 by this population from local social service providers; and

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26 WHEREAS, Greenleaf Family Center serves clients from their existing Moms & Babies
27 First pregnancy support services and will work with the Full Term First Birthday local
28 collaborative to expand services to pregnant women and parents of young children throughout
29 Summit County; and

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31 WHEREAS, due to increased need for the services provided, the Executive wishes to
32 amend the TANF Agreement with Greenleaf Family Center, in an amount not to exceed
33 \$103,300.00 (for a cumulative increase of 41.32%), for a total amount not to exceed
34 \$353,300.00; and

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36 WHEREAS, the Board of Control, at its meeting held May 4, 2022, awarded Change
37 Order No. 1 to the TANF Agreement with Greenleaf Family Center, which is exempt from
38 competitive bidding due to the provider’s subgrantee status, to provide child safety education
39 services and to distribute child safety and basic needs items, to pregnant women and parents of
40 young children, from 7/1/21 through 9/30/22, in an amount not to exceed \$103,300.00 (for a
41 cumulative increase of 41.32%), for a total amount not to exceed \$353,300.00, subject to
42 confirmation by this Council; and

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44 WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information,
45 that the aforementioned Change Order No. 1 to the TANF Agreement with Greenleaf Family
46 Center is necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit;

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4 SECTION 1

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6 The award by the Board of Control of Change Order No. 1 to a Temporary Assistance to
7 Needy Families (“TANF”) Agreement with Greenleaf Family Center to provide child safety
8 education services and to distribute child safety and basic needs items, to pregnant women and
9 parents of young children, from 7/1/21 through 9/30/22, in an amount not to exceed \$103,300.00
10 (for a cumulative increase of 41.32%), for a total amount not to exceed \$353,300.00, is hereby
11 confirmed and the Executive is hereby authorized to execute said Change Order No. 1 and any
12 necessary related documents.

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14 SECTION 2

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16 This Resolution is hereby declared an emergency in the interest of health, safety, and
17 welfare of the residents of the County of Summit, and for the further reason to immediately
18 provide increased child safety education services and distribution child safety and basic needs
19 items, to pregnant women and parents of young children through 9/30/22.

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21 SECTION 3

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23 Provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of eight members, it shall take
24 effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Executive; otherwise, it shall take
25 effect and be in force at the earliest time provided by law.

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27 SECTION 4

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29 It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating
30 to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all
31 deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action,
32 were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section
33 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
