7 **A Resolution authorizing the Executive to advertise for bids for Non-Emergency Medical**
8 **Transportation providers, for an estimated total cost not to exceed \$3,500,000.00, for the**
9 **Executive’s Department Job and Family Services, and declaring an emergency.**

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11 WHEREAS, the Executive’s Department of Job and Family Services coordinates and
12 monitors the Non-Emergency Medical Transportation (“NET”) services for eligible Summit
13 County Medicaid clients through NET providers via portal-to-portal-to-portal transportation,
14 which is funded by federal pass-through Medicaid dollars; and

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16 WHEREAS, Section 177.05 of the Codified Ordinances of the County of Summit
17 requires this Council’s authorization for the Executive to advertise for bids; and

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19 WHEREAS, the Executive wishes to advertise for bids for NET providers for an
20 estimated total cost not to exceed \$3,500,000.00 with the contract period, once awarded, being
21 10/1/22 to 9/30/23, with two options to renew for an additional one-year term; and

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23 WHEREAS, a copy of the bid specifications is on file in the Clerk of Council’s office;

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26 WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information,
27 that is necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit to authorize the Executive to
28 advertise for bids for NET providers;

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30 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State
31 of Ohio, that;

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33 SECTION 1

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35 The Executive is hereby authorized to advertise for bids for Non-Emergency Medical
36 Transportation providers, for an estimated total cost not to exceed \$3,500,000.00.

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38 SECTION 2

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40 This Resolution is declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety, and welfare
41 of the residents of the County of Summit, and for the further reason that it authorizes the
42 Executive to immediately advertise for bids so that necessary Non-Emergency Medical
43 Transportation services may be provided during the grant period.

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45 SECTION 3

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47 Provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of eight members, it shall take
48 effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Executive; otherwise, it shall take
49 effect and be in force at the earliest time provided by law.

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4 SECTION 4

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6 It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating
7 to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all
8 deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were
9 in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section
10 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
