7 **A Resolution confirming the award by the Board of Control of a Temporary Assistance to**
8 **Needy Families Agreement with Early Childhood Resource Center to provide child care**
9 **case management services, from 7/1/2022 through 9/30/23, in an amount not to exceed**
10 **\$70,000.00, for the Executive’s Department of Job and Family Services, and declaring an**
11 **emergency.**

13 WHEREAS, the Executive’s Department of Jobs and Family Services (“DJFS”) seeks to
14 enter into a Temporary Assistance to Needy Families (“TANF”) agreement with Early
15 Childhood Resource Center, to provide for child care case management services; and

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17 WHEREAS, under this proposed agreement, Early Childhood Resource Center will assist
18 clients with day care selection and enrollment processes as well as understanding state funded
19 child care benefits and day care center procedures; and

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21 WHEREAS, Early Childhood Resource Center will provide payment for enrollment,
22 registration and waitlist fees for child care services at state approved child care sites; and

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24 WHEREAS, the Executive wishes to enter into a TANF Agreement with Early
25 Childhood Resource Center to provide the above referenced services; and

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27 WHEREAS, the Board of Control, at its meeting held May 18, 2022, awarded a TANF
28 Agreement with Early Childhood Resource Center, which is exempt from competitive bidding
29 due to the provider’s subgrantee status, to provide child care case management services, from
30 7/1/2022 through 9/30/23, in an amount not to exceed \$70,000.00, subject to confirmation by this
31 Council; and

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33 WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information,
34 that the aforementioned TANF Agreement with Early Childhood Resource Center is necessary
35 and in the best interest of the County of Summit;

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37 NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State
38 of Ohio, that:

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40 SECTION 1

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42 The award by the Board of Control, a Temporary Assistance to Needy Families
43 (“TANF”) Agreement with Early Childhood Resource Center to provide child care case
44 management services, from 7/1/2022 through 9/30/23, in an amount not to exceed \$70,000.00, is
45 hereby confirmed and the Executive is hereby authorized to execute said agreement and any
46 other necessary related documents.

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48 SECTION 2

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50 This Resolution is hereby declared an emergency in the interest of health, safety, and
51 welfare of the residents of the County of Summit, and for the further reason to child care case
52 management services as expeditiously as possible.

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4 SECTION 3

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6 Provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of eight members, it shall take
7 effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Executive; otherwise, it shall take
8 effect and be in force at the earliest time provided by law.

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10 SECTION 4

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12 It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating
13 to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all
14 deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action,
15 were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section
16 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
