7 **A Resolution confirming the award by the Board of Control of Change Order No. 1 to a**
8 **Temporary Assistance to Needy Families Agreement with the Akron-Canton Regional**
9 **Food Bank for food distribution services to food pantries throughout the County, from**
10 **10/1/21 through 9/30/22, in an amount not to exceed \$100,000.00, (for a cumulative increase**
11 **of 37.74%) for a total amount not to exceed \$365,000.00, for the Executive’s Department of**
12 **Job and Family Services, and declaring an emergency.**

14 WHEREAS, this Council previously adopted Resolution No, 2021-258, which authorized
15 the Executive to execute a Temporary Assistance to Needy Families (“TANF”) Agreement with
16 the Akron-Canton Regional Food Bank for food distribution services to food pantries throughout
17 the County, from 10/1/21 through 9/30/22, in an amount not to exceed \$265,000.00; and

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19 WHEREAS, the Executive’s Department of Job and Family Services wishes to amend its
20 TANF Agreement with the Akron-Canton Regional Food Bank to meet the increased client
21 demand for food distribution services in the County; and

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23 WHEREAS, the Executive wishes to enter into Change Order No. 1 to the TANF
24 Agreement with the Akron-Canton Regional Food Bank to provide the aforementioned
25 additional services; and

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27 WHEREAS, the Board of Control, at its meeting held May 18, 2022, awarded Change
28 Order No. 1 to a TANF Agreement with the Akron-Canton Regional Food Bank for food
29 distribution services to food pantries throughout the County, from 10/1/21 through 9/30/22, in an
30 amount not to exceed \$100,000.00, (for a cumulative increase of 37.74%) for a total amount not
31 to exceed \$365,000.00, subject to confirmation by this Council; and

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33 WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information
34 that the aforementioned Change Order No. 1 to a TANF Agreement with the Akron-Canton
35 Regional Food Bank is necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit;

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37 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State
38 of Ohio, that:

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42 The award by the Board of Control of Change Order No. 1 to a Temporary Assistance to
43 Needy Families (“TANF”) Agreement with the Akron-Canton Regional Food Bank for food
44 distribution services to food pantries throughout the County, from 10/1/21 through 9/30/22, in an
45 amount not to exceed \$100,000.00, (for a cumulative increase of 37.74%) for a total amount not
46 to exceed \$365,000.00, is hereby confirmed and the Executive is hereby authorized to execute
47 said change order and any other necessary related documents.

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6 This Resolution is hereby declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety and
7 welfare of the residents of the County of Summit, and for the further reason to immediately
8 confirm the award of a necessary change order to a TANF Agreement in order to immediately
9 provide additional food distribution services by the Akron-Canton Regional Food Bank.

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13 Provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of eight members, it shall take
14 effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Executive; otherwise, it shall take
15 effect and be in force at the earliest time provided by law.

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19 It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating
20 to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all
21 deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action,
