7 **A Resolution confirming the award by the Board of Control of a construction contract with**
8 **Chagrin Valley Paving, Inc. for the Olde 8 Road Resurfacing Project, at a total cost not to**
9 **exceed \$1,379,306.49, with a local cash match not to exceed \$679,306.49, located in**
10 **Northfield Center Township, in Council District 1, for the Engineer, and declaring an**
11 **emergency.**

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13 WHEREAS, the Olde 8 Road Resurfacing Project (the "Project") will improve Olde 8
14 Road from the border of Boston Heights to the southern Highland Road intersection including
15 pavement repairs, widening and resurfacing shoulders where possible and resurfacing the
16 roadway. This project will also install north bound and south bound left turn lanes on Olde Eight
17 Road at the Twinsburg Road intersection; and

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19 WHEREAS, federal funds will cover \$700,000.00 towards the total construction cost of
20 \$1,379,306.49 and the Executive and Engineer have requested AMATS provide an additional
21 15% towards the construction of the Project; and

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23 WHEREAS, this Council previously adopted Resolution No. 2020-235, which authorized
24 the Executive to enter into a Local Public Agency agreement with the State of Ohio for this
25 project; and

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27 WHEREAS, this Council subsequently adopted Resolution 2021-388, which authorized
28 the Executive to advertise for bids for the Project, as part of bridge engineering and construction
29 projects, and pavement maintenance projects, for the Engineer's 2022 Capital Improvements
30 Program, and federal and state funded projects, for an estimated total cost not to exceed
31 \$12,724,400.00; and

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33 WHEREAS, said projects were approved as part of the Capital Improvements Program
34 for 2022-2027 by Resolution No. 2022-032; and

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36 WHEREAS, following the receipt and review of bids, the Executive has proposed
37 entering into a construction contract with Chagrin Valley Paving, Inc., at a total cost not to
38 exceed \$1,379,306.49, with a local cash match not to exceed \$679,306.49; and

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40 WHEREAS, the Board of Control, at its meeting held on June 8, 2022, awarded a
41 construction contract with Chagrin Valley Paving, Inc., as the lowest responsive and responsible
42 bidder, for the Project, at a total cost not to exceed \$1,379,306.49, with a local cash match not to
43 exceed \$679,306.49, subject to confirmation by this Council; and

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45 WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information,
46 that the aforementioned construction contract with Chagrin Valley Paving, Inc. for the Project is
47 necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit;

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49 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State

4 SECTION 1

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6 The award by the Board of Control of construction contract with Chagrin Valley Paving,
7 Inc., at a total cost not to exceed \$1,379,306.49, with a local cash match not to exceed
8 \$679,306.49, is hereby confirmed and the Executive is hereby authorized to execute said
9 construction contract and any other necessary related documents.

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11 SECTION 2

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13 This Resolution is hereby declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety and
14 welfare of the residents of the County of Summit, and for the further purpose to immediately
15 provide necessary pavement repairs to Olde 8 Road.

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17 SECTION 3

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19 Provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of eight members, it shall take
20 effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Executive; otherwise, it shall take
21 effect and be in force at the earliest time provided by law.

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23 SECTION 4

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25 It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating
26 to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all
27 deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action,
28 were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section
29 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.


