A Resolution authorizing the Executive to approve the 2022 wage reopener agreed between Ohio Council 8 and Local 2696 of the American Federation of State, County and Municipal Employees, AFL-CIO, the Executive and the Executive's Department of Job and Family Services, for the second year of the parties' collective bargaining agreement (1/1/22 through 12/31/22), for the Executive, and declaring an emergency.

WHEREAS, in Resolution No. 2021-224 a collective bargaining agreement and memorandum of understanding was approved between Ohio Council 8 and Local 2696 of the American Federation of State, County and Municipal Employees, AFL-CIO (collectively, the "Union"), and the Executive and the Executive's Department of Job and Family Services, for the period 1/1/21 through 12/31/23, with a reopener on wages in the second and third year of the agreement (1/1/2022 and 1/1/2023); and

WHEREAS, the Executive and the Union have reached an agreement on the 2022 wage reopener with an increase in pay of two and one-half percent (2.5%) in the second year of the agreement (effective 1/1/2022); and

WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information, that it is necessary and in the best interest of the County to approve the wage reopener between the Union and the Executive and the Executive's Department of Job and Family Services as agreed between the parties;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State of Ohio, that:

SECTION 1

The agreement on the wage reopener between Ohio Council 8 and Local 2696 of the American Federation of State, County and Municipal Employees, AFL-CIO, and the Executive and the Executive's Department of Job and Family Services, for the second year of the collective bargaining agreement, effective January 1, 2022, is hereby approved, authorizing an increase in pay of two and one-half percent (2.5%).

SECTION 2

This Resolution is hereby declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety, and welfare of the residents of the County of Summit and for the for the further purpose of providing a timely wage increase for the bargaining unit members of Local 2696 of the American Federation of State, County and Municipal Employees, AFL-CIO.
