7 **A Resolution confirming the award by the Board of Control of a renewal (second of four)**  
8 **of a purchase contract with Aramark Correctional Services, LLC, for detention center**  
9 **youth food services, for the period of 7/1/22 through 6/30/23, for a total amount not to**  
10 **exceed \$220,000.00, for the Court of Common Pleas-Juvenile Division, and declaring an**  
11 **emergency.**

13 WHEREAS, this Council previously adopted Resolution No. 2020-136, which confirmed  
14 the award by the Board of Control of a purchase contract with Aramark Correctional Services,  
15 LLC, for detention center youth food services, for the period of 7/1/20 through 6/30/21, with four  
16 options to renew for a one-year period, in an estimated amount not to exceed \$200,000.00 for the  
17 first year, for the Court of Common Pleas-Juvenile Division; and

18  
19 WHEREAS, this Council subsequently adopted Resolution No. 2021-197, which  
20 confirmed the award by the Board of Control of a renewal (first of four) of a purchase contract  
21 with Aramark Correctional Services, LLC, for detention center youth food services, for the  
22 period of 7/1/21 through 6/30/22, for the Court of Common Pleas-Juvenile Division; and

23  
24 WHEREAS, the Board of Control, at its meeting held June 15, 2022, awarded a renewal  
25 (second of four) of a purchase contract with Aramark Correctional Services, LLC, for detention  
26 center youth food services, for a one-year term, from 7/1/22 through 6/30/23, in an amount not to  
27 exceed \$5.385 per meal and \$0.705 per snack, for a total amount not to exceed \$220,000.00,  
28 subject to confirmation by this Council; and

30 WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information,  
31 that the aforementioned renewal of a purchase contract with Aramark Correctional Services,  
32 LLC is necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit;

34 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State  
35 of Ohio, that:

39 The award by the Board of Control of a renewal (second of four) of a purchase contract  
40 with Aramark Correctional Services, LLC, for detention center youth food services, for a one-  
41 year term, from 7/1/22 through 6/30/23, in an amount not to exceed \$5.385 per meal and \$0.705  
42 per snack, for a total amount not to exceed \$220,000.00, is hereby confirmed, and the Executive  
43 is hereby authorized to execute said renewal and any other necessary related documents.

47 This Resolution is hereby declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety and  
48 welfare of the residents of the County of Summit, and for the further purpose to immediately  
49 provide detention center youth food services effective 7/1/22.

16 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.


