A Resolution amending Resolution No. 2021-170 to change the contract period to a one-year agreement with one option to renew for a four-year term, for a professional service contract with NFP Corporate Services OH, Inc. for general consulting services for health and wellness benefits, and to renew said agreement for an amount not to exceed \$955,000.00, for the four-year renewal period, from 10/1/22 through 9/30/26, for the Executive's Department of Human Resources, Division of Employee Benefits, and declaring an emergency.

WHEREAS, this Council previously adopted Resolution No. 2021-170, which confirmed the award by the Board of Control (BOC Directive No. 170-21) of a professional service contract with NFP Corporate Services OH, Inc. for general consulting services for health and wellness benefits, for a one-year term, from 10/1/21 through 9/30/22, with four options to renew for an additional one-year term, for an amount not to exceed \$235,000.00; and

WHEREAS, the parties of said professional services contract wish to lock in the rates in the agreement for the remaining four years, and increase efficiency by obtaining approval for a four-year contract period; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Control, at its meeting held on August 10, 2022, amended its prior Directive No. 170-21 to change the contract period to a one-year agreement with one option to renew for a four-year term, instead of a one-year agreement with four one-year renewals, for a professional service contract with NFP Corporate Services OH, Inc. for general consulting services for health and wellness benefits, for an amount not to exceed \$955,000.00, for the four-year renewal period, from 10/1/22 through 9/30/26; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Control, at its meeting held on August 10, 2022, awarded a renewal (first and last) of a professional service contract with NFP Corporate Services OH, Inc. for general consulting services for health and wellness benefits for a period of four years, from 10/1/22 through 9/30/26, for an amount not to exceed \$955,000.00, subject to confirmation by this Council; and

WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information, that it is necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit to amend Resolution No. 2021-170, and to renew the agreement with NFP Corporate Services OH, Inc. as amended, for the aforementioned reasons;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State of Ohio, that:

SECTION 1

Resolution No. 2021-170 is hereby amended to change the contract period to a one-year agreement with one option to renew for a four-year term, instead of a one-year agreement with four one-year renewals, for a professional service contract with NFP Corporate Services OH, Inc. for general consulting services for health and wellness benefits.

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SECTION 2

The award by the Board of Control of a renewal (first and last) of a professional service contract with NFP Corporate Services OH, Inc. for general consulting services for health and wellness benefits, for an amount not to exceed \$955,000.00, for a four-year renewal period, from 10/1/22 through 9/30/26, is hereby confirmed, and the Executive is hereby authorized to execute said renewal and any other necessary documents.

SECTION 3

This Resolution is declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety and welfare of the residents of the County of Summit, and for the further reason that it is necessary to immediately provide the County general consulting services for health and wellness benefits.

SECTION 4

Provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of eight members, it shall take effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Executive; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force at the earliest time provided by law.

SECTION 5

It is found and determined that all formal actions of the Council concerning and relating to the adoption of the Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
