7 **A Resolution confirming the award by the Board of Control of a purchase contract with**  
8 **Kimble Recycling and Disposal, Inc., for the disposal of sludge from both the Fishcreek**  
9 **Wastewater Treatment Plant #25, located in the City of Stow, in Council District 3, and the**  
10 **Upper Tuscarawas Wastewater Treatment Plant #36, located in Springfield Township, in**  
11 **Council District 8, to a solid waste landfill, for a three year term, from 7/1/22 to 6/30/25, in**  
12 **an amount not to exceed \$819,405.00, for the Executive's Department of Sanitary Sewer**  
13 **Services, and declaring an emergency.**

14  
15 WHEREAS, this Council previously adopted Resolution No. 2022-167, which authorized  
16 the Executive to advertise for bids for the disposal of sludge from both the Fishcreek Wastewater  
17 Treatment Plant ("WWTP") #25, located in the City of Stow, and the Upper Tuscarawas WWTP  
18 #36, located in Springfield Township, in Council Districts 3 and 8, respectively, to a solid waste  
19 landfill, for an estimated annual cost not to exceed \$275,220.00, for a three year term for an  
20 estimated total cost not to exceed \$825,660.00; and

22 WHEREAS, the Executive selected Kimble Recycling and Disposal, Inc., as the lowest  
23 responsive and responsible bidder, for the disposal of sludge from both the Fishcreek WWTP  
24 #25, located in the City of Stow, and the Upper Tuscarawas WWTP #36, located in Springfield  
25 Township, in Council Districts 3 and 8, respectively; and

27 WHEREAS, the Board of Control, at its meeting held August 24, 2022, awarded a  
28 purchase contract with Kimble Recycling and Disposal, Inc., for the disposal of sludge from both  
29 the Fishcreek WWTP #25, located in the City of Stow, and the Upper Tuscarawas WWTP #36,  
30 located in Springfield Township, in Council Districts 3 and 8, respectively, to a solid waste  
31 landfill, for a three year term, from 7/1/22 to 6/30/25, in an amount not to exceed \$819,405.00,  
32 subject to confirmation by this Council; and

34 WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information,  
35 that the aforementioned purchase contract with Kimble Recycling and Disposal, Inc. is necessary  
36 and in the best interest of the County of Summit;

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38 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State

43 The award by the Board of Control of a purchase contract with Kimble Recycling and  
44 Disposal, Inc., for the disposal of sludge from both the Fishcreek Wastewater Treatment Plan  
45 ("WWTP") #25, located in the City of Stow, and the Upper Tuscarawas WWTP #36, located in  
46 Springfield Township, in Council Districts 3 and 8, respectively, to a solid waste landfill, for a  
47 three year term, from 7/1/22 to 6/30/25, in an amount not to exceed \$819,405.00, is hereby  
48 confirmed and the Executive is hereby authorized to execute said purchase contract and any  
49 other necessary related documents.

7 of the residents of the County of Summit, and for the further reason to immediately provide for  
8 the removal and disposal of sludge from the City of Stow and Springfield Township.

13 effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Executive; otherwise, it shall take  
14 effect and be in force at the earliest time provided by law.
