7 **A Resolution confirming the award by the Board of Control of Change Order No. 2 to a**  
8 **construction contract with Krumroy-Cozad Construction, Inc. for the Summit County Jail**  
9 **Video Arraignment Project at the Jail, located in the City of Akron, in Council District 4,**  
10 **in an amount not to exceed \$86,015.37, (for a cumulative increase of 156.2%) for a total**  
11 **amount not to exceed \$519,565.37, for the Executive's Department of Administrative**  
12 **Services-Physical Plants, and declaring an emergency.**

13 WHEREAS, this Council previously adopted Resolution No. 2020-297, which authorized  
14 the Executive to execute a construction contract with Krumroy-Cozad Construction, Inc. to build  
15 small rooms inside the existing housing units at the Jail to host virtual meetings and hearings for  
16 inmates instead of transporting them to and from the Summit County Courthouse for the Summit  
17 County Jail Arraignment Project; and

19 WHEREAS, this Council subsequently adopted Resolution No. 2021-194, which  
20 confirmed the award by the Board of Control of Change Order No. 1 to a construction contract  
21 with Krumroy-Cozad Construction, Inc. for the Summit County Jail Video Arraignment Project  
22 at the Jail, located in the City of Akron, in Council District 4, in an amount not to exceed  
23 \$230,730.00, (for a cumulative increase of 114%) for a total amount not to exceed \$433,550.00;

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26 WHEREAS, the Executive wishes to amend the contract with Krumroy-Cozad,  
27 Construction, Inc. to add sound deadening ceiling panels as well as double pane plexiglass to  
28 lessen the sound transmission between the video rooms which will improve the quality of the  
29 video sound system and maintain privacy for attorney-client meetings; and

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31 WHEREAS, the Executive wishes to enter into Change Order No. 2 to the construction  
32 contract with Krumroy-Cozad Construction, Inc. to provide the above referenced additional  
33 improvements to the video arraignment rooms; and

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35 WHEREAS, the Board of Control, at its meeting held August 24, 2022, awarded Change  
36 Order No. 2 to the construction contract with Krumroy-Cozad Construction, Inc. for the Summit  
37 County Jail Video Arraignment Project at the Jail, located in the City of Akron, in Council  
38 District 4, in an amount not to exceed \$86,015.37, (for a cumulative increase of 156.2%) for a  
39 total amount not to exceed \$519,565.37, subject to confirmation by this Council; and

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41 WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information,  
42 that Change Order No. 2 to the aforementioned construction contract with Krumroy-Cozad  
43 Construction, Inc. is necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit:

50 The award by the Board of Control of Change Order No. 2 to a construction contract with

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6 Jail, located in the City of Akron, in Council District 4, in an amount not to exceed \$86,015.37,  
7 (for a cumulative increase of 156.2%) for a total amount not to exceed \$519,565.37, is hereby  
8 confirmed and the Executive is hereby authorized to execute said Change Order and any  
9 necessary related documents.

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11 SECTION 2

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13 This Resolution is declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety, and welfare  
14 of the residents of the County of Summit, and for the further reason to immediately confirm the  
15 award of a necessary change order for video arraignment services to improve operations at the  
16 Jail and to ensure that defendants' and inmates' constitutional rights are protected.

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18 SECTION 3

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20 Provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of eight members, it shall take  
21 effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Executive; otherwise, it shall take  
22 effect and be in force at the earliest time provided by law.

24 SECTION 4

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26 It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating  
27 to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all  
28 deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were  
29 in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section  
30 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.


