7 **A Resolution declaring the month of October 2022 as Breast Cancer Awareness Month in**
8 **Summit County, recognizing our survivors, our loved ones lost to breast cancer, and our**
9 **caregivers that supported them throughout their battles, reaffirming the need for early**
10 **detection and a cure for breast cancer, and encouraging residents to wear pink on October**
11 **23, 2022, for the Council and the Executive, and declaring an emergency.**

13 WHEREAS, the National Breast Cancer Foundation reports that in 2022 an estimated
14 338,900 women and 2,710 men will be diagnosed with breast cancer and an estimated 43,550
15 women and 530 men will die of breast cancer in the United States; and

17 WHEREAS, breast cancer is the second most common cancer among women in the United
18 States, with 1 in 8 women being diagnosed with breast cancer in their lifetime; and

20 WHEREAS, there are over 3.8 million breast cancer survivors in the United States that
21 through their courage and strength and through advancements in prevention and care have won
22 their battle against breast cancer; and

24 WHEREAS, there are millions of people impacted by breast cancer every year, including
25 thousands of residents and their families in Summit County; and

27 WHEREAS, by advocating for research to prevent, treat, and cure breast cancer, by
28 encouraging our loved ones to commit to routine screening, and by supporting our loved ones
29 through their struggles with breast cancer, our community can become happier and healthier; and

31 WHEREAS, residents are encouraged to wear pink on October 23, 2022, in recognition of
32 Breast Cancer Awareness Month and in solidarity with all those who have been impacted by breast
33 cancer; and

35 WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information,
36 that it is necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit that October 2022 be declared
37 Breast Cancer Awareness Month in Summit County, and encouraging the residents of Summit
38 County to join in this acknowledgement by wearing pink on October 23, 2022;

40 NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State

SECTION 2


SECTION 4


