7 **A Resolution confirming the award by the Board of Control of a purchase contract with**
8 **Nesco Resource, LLC fka Callos Resource LLC, for payroll services for the period 10/1/22**
9 **through 9/30/23, for various youth employment programs, including summer youth and**
10 **year-round programs, with three options to renew for additional one-year terms, in an**
11 **amount not to exceed \$1,395,683.95, for the Executive’s Department of Job and Family**
12 **Services, and declaring an emergency.**

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14 WHEREAS, this Council previously adopted Resolution No. 2022-145, which authorized
15 the Executive to advertise for bids for payroll services for youth employment programs, for an
16 estimated total cost not to exceed \$1,400,000.00; and

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18 WHEREAS, the bid in the amount not to exceed \$1,395,683.95, provided by Nesco
19 Resource, LLC fka Callos Resource LLC (hereinafter “Nesco”) included three options to renew
20 for additional one year periods and the Executive’s Department of Job and Family Services
21 (“DJFS”) seeks to renew its agreement with Summit and Medina Workforce Area Council of
22 Governments (“SAMWA COG”) and Nesco to provide the aforementioned payroll services with
23 administrative costs estimated at \$20,818.95 and \$1,375,045.00 in passthrough funds for youth
24 payroll including wages, incentives, payroll taxes and workers’ compensation costs; and

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26 WHEREAS, DJFS seeks to enter an agreement with SAMWA COG and Nesco to
27 provide payroll services for various youth and adult employment programs, including summer
28 youth and year round programs; and

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30 WHEREAS, by having one payroll service provider, the burden of meeting payroll and
31 carrying workers’ compensation coverage is alleviated for non-profits and employer sites for
32 these temporary employees; and

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34 WHEREAS, the State of Ohio recognizes this method as a cost effective manner to
35 handle issuance of pay (youth wage subsidies) and workers’ compensation liability; and

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37 WHEREAS, under this agreement, DJFS and SAMWA COG act as “grantors” of
38 Workforce Innovation and Opportunity Act (“WIOA”) and Temporary Assistance to Needy
39 Families (“TANF”) funding for the provision of these services; and

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41 WHEREAS, the overall cost of said payroll services for this renewal is based on the
42 various employment programs enrolling up to 500 local youth; and

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44 WHEREAS, the Board of Control, at its meeting held August 24, 2022, awarded a
45 purchase contract with Nesco, for payroll services for the period 10/1/22 through 9/30/23, for
46 various youth employment programs, including summer youth and year-round programs, with
47 three options to renew for additional one-year terms, in an amount not to exceed \$1,395,683.95,
48 subject to confirmation by this Council; and

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4 WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information,
5 that the aforementioned purchase contract with Nesco is necessary and in the best interest of the
6 County of Summit;

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8 NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State
9 of Ohio, that:

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11 SECTION 1

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13 The award by the Board of Control of a purchase contract with Nesco Resource, LLC fka
14 Callos Resource LLC, for payroll services for the period 10/1/22 through 9/30/23, for various
15 youth employment programs, including summer youth and year-round programs, with three
16 options to renew for additional one-year terms, in an amount not to exceed \$1,395,683.95, is
17 hereby confirmed and the Executive is hereby authorized to execute said purchase contract and
18 any other necessary related documents.

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20 SECTION 2

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22 This Resolution is hereby declared an emergency in the interest of health, safety and
23 welfare of the residents of the County of Summit, and for the further reason that it is necessary to
24 immediately provide required payroll services for various youth employment programs.

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26 SECTION 3

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28 Provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of eight members, it shall take
29 effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Executive; otherwise, it shall take
30 effect and be in force at the earliest time provided by law.


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32 SECTION 4

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34 It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating
35 to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all
36 deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action,
37 were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including
38 Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

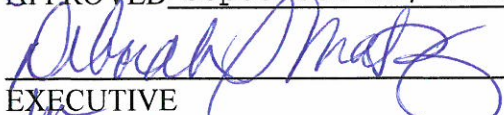
