A Resolution authorizing the Executive to execute an agreement with Fidelity and Deposit Company of Maryland, to assign the construction payment obligations under the construction contract with The Knoch Corporation for the Operations Fleet Maintenance Facility Project Q-614, located in the City of Akron, in Council District 4, for the Executive's Department of Sanitary Sewer Services, and declaring an emergency.

WHEREAS, this Council previously adopted Resolution No. 2020-128, which authorized the Executive to execute a construction contract and any other necessary related documents with The Knoch Corporation ("Knoch") for the Operations Fleet Maintenance Facility Project Q-614 (the "Project"), located in the City of Akron, in Council District 4, in the amount not to exceed \$9,720,598.00 (the "Contract"); and

WHEREAS, pursuant to the terms of the Contract, Knoch provided a performance bond issued by the Fidelity and Deposit Company of Maryland ("F&D") that in the event Knoch failed to pay all lawful claims of subcontractors, material persons and laborers, then F&D would pay all such claims related to the Project; and

WHEREAS, F&D has notified the County that it has paid a claim made by a subcontractor that Knoch failed to pay for work completed for the Project; and

WHEREAS, F&D has notified the County that pursuant to the terms of the Contract, the payments made by the County to fund the Project shall be assigned from Knoch to F&D; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary for the County to enter into an agreement with F&D to allow F&D to take over the payment of all lawful claims of subcontractors, material persons and laborers for the Project pursuant to the terms of the Contract; and

WHEREAS, this Council has determined, after reviewing all pertinent information, that it is necessary and in the best interest of the County to authorize the Executive to execute the aforementioned agreement;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State of Ohio, that:

## SECTION 1

The Executive is hereby authorized to execute an agreement and any necessary related documents with the Fidelity and Deposit Company of Maryland ("F&D") that shall allow F&D to be assigned the rights to take over the payment obligations for all lawful claims of subcontractors, material persons and laborers pursuant to the terms of the construction contract (the "Contract") with The Knoch Corporation for the Operations Fleet Maintenance Facility Project Q-614.

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## **SECTION 2**

 This Resolution is hereby declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety and welfare of the residents of the County of Summit, and for the further reason that it immediately authorizes the execution of the aforementioned necessary agreement to comply with the payment obligations under the Contract.

## **SECTION 3**

Provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of eight members, it shall take effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Executive; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force at the earliest time provided by law.

## **SECTION 4**

It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.05 of the Ohio Revised Code.
