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7 **A Resolution certifying delinquent sewer service charges to the Fiscal Officer, for the**
8 **Executive's Department of Sanitary Sewer Services, and declaring an emergency.**
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10 WHEREAS, the billing records at the Executive's Department of Sanitary Sewer
11 Services show delinquent sewer service accounts which represent unpaid sewer service charges
12 for the past year; and

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14 WHEREAS, Sections 6103.02 and 6117.02 of the Ohio Revised Code provide that these
15 charges are to be certified to the Fiscal Officer and placed on the real property tax list duplicate
16 for collection; and

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18 WHEREAS, the delinquent sewer service charges shall be levied in the 2023 collection
19 year and split equally between 1st and 2nd half collections; and

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21 WHEREAS, this Council has determined by reviewing all pertinent information that
22 certifying the aforementioned sewer service charges to the Fiscal Officer is necessary and in the
23 best interest of County of Summit;

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25 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State
26 of Ohio, that:

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28 SECTION 1

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30 The delinquent sewer service charges listed in Exhibit A, attached to this Resolution and
31 incorporated herein as if fully restated, are hereby certified to the Fiscal Officer in the amounts
32 stated in the "Balance" column in Exhibit A, to be placed on the real property tax list and
33 duplicate on their respective parcels for collection as other taxes are collected.

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35 SECTION 2

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37 The Clerk of Council shall deliver a copy of this Resolution to the Fiscal Officer who
38 shall record the delinquent sewer service charges for collection pursuant to state law.

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40 SECTION 3

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42 This Resolution is hereby declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety and
43 welfare of the residents of the County of Summit, and for the further reason to immediately
44 ensure the certification of sewer service charges to the Fiscal Officer.

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46 SECTION 4

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48 Provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of eight members, it shall take
49 effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Executive; otherwise, it shall take
50 effect and be in force at the earliest time provided by law.

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SECTION 5

It is found and determined that all formal actions of the Council concerning and relating to the adoption of the Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
