7 **An Ordinance amending Section 109.04 of the Codified Ordinances of the County of**
8 **Summit entitled “Records Commission,” to include the County of Summit Transportation**
9 **Improvement District under the authority of the County Records Commission, for the**
10 **Executive’s Department of Community and Economic Development, and declaring an**
11 **emergency.**

12
13 WHEREAS, Section 109.04 of the Codified Ordinances of the County of Summit,
14 entitled “Records Commission,” creates the County Records Commission and defines its
15 membership and authority; and

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17 WHEREAS, that section further authorizes the Executive to enter into agreements with
18 Councils of Governments and Special Taxing Districts to act as the records commission for those
19 bodies; and

21 WHEREAS, the County has a Transportation Improvement District (the “District”)
22 which is organized under Chapter 5540 of the Ohio Revised Code, and which the District is a
23 body corporate and politic thus necessitating its properly maintaining its records as public
24 records and requiring the establishment of a records commission; and

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26 WHEREAS, the District Board, at its meeting on _____ authorized an agreement
27 between the District and the County for the County Records Commission to act as the District’s
28 Records Commission as set forth on Exhibit A, a copy of which is attached hereto and
29 incorporated herein as if fully restated; and

31 WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information,
32 that it is necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit to amend Section 109.04 of
33 the Codified Ordinances of the County of Summit for the reasons set forth above;

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35 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the County of Summit, State
36 of Ohio, that:

38 SECTION 1

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40 Effective September X, 2022, Section 109.04 of the Codified Ordinances of the County
41 of Summit, entitled “Records Commission,” is hereby amended as set forth on Exhibit A, a copy
42 of which is attached hereto and incorporated herein as if fully restated.

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44 SECTION 2

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46 This Ordinance is hereby declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety, and
47 welfare of the residents of the County of Summit and for the further purpose of immediately
48 amending Section 109.04 of the Codified Ordinances of the County of Summit in order to ensure
49 that the County’s Transportation Improvement District is properly maintaining and disposing of
50 records within the requirements of Ohio’s Public Records Act.

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4 SECTION 3

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6 Provided this Ordinance received the affirmative vote of eight members, it shall take
7 effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Executive; otherwise, it shall take
8 effect and be in force at the earliest time provided by law.

10 SECTION 4

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12 It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating
13 to the adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all
14 deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action,
15 were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section
16 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
