7 **A Resolution authorizing the Executive to advertise for separate bids for the Pavilion**  
8 **Construction Project and the Paving Improvement Project, both for the Summit County**  
9 **Children Services Administration Building, located in the City of Akron, in Council**  
10 **District 4, for estimated total costs not to exceed \$213,840.00 and \$314,000.00, respectively,**  
11 **for the Executive's Department of Administrative Services-Physical Plants, and declaring**  
12 **an emergency.**

13  
14 WHEREAS, the Administration Building for Summit County Children Services  
15 ("SCCS"), located at 264 S Arlington St, Akron, Ohio, in Council District 4, was built in 1996;  
16 and

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18 WHEREAS, SCCS periodically holds outside events that require rental and installation of  
19 a tent and the Pavilion Construction Project would provide a permanent structure for said events;  
20 and

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22 WHEREAS, the SCCS Administration Building's parking lot was installed in 1996 and  
23 has only had patch repairs and sealcoating done to it since that time. The Paving Construction  
24 Project would grind and overlay the front lot dramatically improving it. The rear lot will be done  
25 at a later date; and

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27 WHEREAS, the Executive wishes to undertake both the Pavilion Construction Project  
28 and the Paving Improvement Project to improve and prolong the serviceability of the SCCS  
29 Administration Building; and

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31 WHEREAS, Section 177.05 of the Codified Ordinances of the County of Summit  
32 requires this Council's authorization for the Executive to advertise for bids; and

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34 WHEREAS, the Executive wishes to advertise for bids for the aforementioned Pavilion  
35 Construction Project, for an estimated total cost not to exceed \$213,840.00, and the  
36 aforementioned Paving Improvement Project, for an estimated total cost not to exceed  
37 \$314,000.00; and

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39 WHEREAS, a copy of the bid specifications for each project is on file in the Clerk of  
40 Council's Office; and

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42 WHEREAS, this Council will also review and award separate contracts for each of the  
43 above listed projects; and

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45 WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information,  
46 that is necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit to authorize the Executive to  
47 advertise for bids for the Pavilion Construction Project, for estimated total costs not to exceed  
48 \$213,840.00, and for the Paving Improvement Project for an estimated total cost not to exceed  
49 \$314,000.00;

51 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State

4 SECTION 1

5  
6 The Executive is hereby authorized to advertise for bids for the Pavilion Construction  
7 Project, for the Summit County Children Services Administration Building, located in the City of  
8 Akron, in District 4, for an estimated total cost not to exceed \$213,840.00.

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10 SECTION 2

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12 The Executive is hereby authorized to advertise for bids for the Paving Improvement  
13 Project, for the Summit County Children Services Administration Building, located in the City of  
14 Akron, in District 4, for an estimated total cost not to exceed \$314,000.00.

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16 SECTION 3

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18 This Resolution is declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety, and welfare  
19 of the residents of the County of Summit, and for the further reason that it authorizes the  
20 Executive to immediately advertisement for bids for necessary improvements at the Summit  
21 County Children Services Building.

23 SECTION 4

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25 Provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of eight members, it shall take  
26 effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Executive; otherwise, it shall take  
27 effect and be in force at the earliest time provided by law.

29 SECTION 5

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31 It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating  
32 to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all  
33 deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were  
34 in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section  
35 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.


