7 **A Resolution confirming the award by the Board of Control of a renewal (first of two) of a**
8 **professional service contract with the Battered Women’s Shelter of Summit and Medina**
9 **Counties for family stability case management and homelessness prevention services, for a**
10 **one-year term, from 10/1/22 through 9/30/23, in an amount not to exceed \$1,000,000.00, for**
11 **the Executive’s Department of Job and Family Services, and declaring an emergency.**

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13 WHEREAS, this Council previously adopted Resolution No. 2021-258, which confirmed
14 the award by the Board of Control of a professional service contract with the Battered Women’s
15 Shelter of Summit and Medina Counties (“BWS”) to provide family stability case management
16 and homeless prevention services, for the period 10/1/21 through 9/30/22, with two options to
17 renew for an additional one-year term, in an amount not to exceed \$1,000,000.00; and

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19 WHEREAS, the Executive’s Department of Job and Family Services (“DJFS”) wishes to
20 enter into a renewal of an agreement with the BWS to provide family stability case management
21 and homeless prevention services for victims of domestic violence; and

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23 WHEREAS, case management services will assist participants in addressing domestic
24 violence issues that prohibit successful employment and provide support in establishing self-
25 sufficient, violence free lives. Homeless prevention services will be provided for Temporary
26 Assistance to Needy Families (“TANF”) eligible families seeking family stability case
27 management services and housing/utility financial assistance. Financial assistance may include
28 one or more of the following: short term rental assistance, security deposits, utility payments
29 and moving expense assistance; and

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31 WHEREAS, said contract renewal will be funded utilizing TANF, Benefit Bridge and
32 State General Revenue Funds; and

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34 WHEREAS, the Board of Control, at its meeting held September 28, 2022, awarded a
35 renewal (first of two) of a professional service contract with the BWS for family stability case
36 management and homelessness prevention services, for a one-year term, from 10/1/22 through
37 9/30/23, in an amount not to exceed \$1,000,000.00, subject to confirmation by this Council; and

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39 WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information,
40 that the aforementioned renewal of a professional service contract with the BWS is necessary
41 and in the best interest of the County of Summit;

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43 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State
44 of Ohio, that:

48 The award by the Board of Control of a renewal (first of two) of a professional service
49 contract with the Battered Women’s Shelter of Summit and Medina Counties for family stability
50 case management and homelessness prevention services, for a one-year term, from 10/1/22
51 through 9/30/23, in an amount not to exceed \$1,000,000.00, is hereby confirmed and the
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SECTION 1 (Continued)

Executive is hereby authorized to execute said renewal of a professional service contract and any other necessary related documents.

SECTION 2

This Resolution is hereby declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety and welfare of the residents of the County of Summit, and for the further reason to immediately provide family stability case management and homeless prevention services for victims of domestic violence to eligible Summit County residents effective 10/1/22.

SECTION 3

Provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of eight members, it shall take effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Executive; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force at the earliest time provided by law.

SECTION 4

It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.


