7 **A Resolution approving a collective bargaining agreement between the Court of Common**  
8 **Pleas-Juvenile Division and Teamsters Local #348, affiliated with the International**  
9 **Brotherhood of Teamsters, for the period 10/1/22 through 9/30/25, for the Court of**  
10 **Common Pleas-Juvenile Division, and declaring an emergency.**

11  
12 WHEREAS, in 2017, the Court of Common Pleas-Juvenile Division (“Juvenile Court”)   
13 opted to voluntarily recognize a collective bargaining unit consisting of its detention facility   
14 workers and organized by the Teamsters Local #348, affiliated with the International   
15 Brotherhood of Teamsters; and

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17 WHEREAS, a collective bargaining agreement has been negotiated and agreed to in   
18 principal between the Juvenile Court and Teamsters Local #348, for the period 10/1/22 through   
19 9/30/25; and

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21 WHEREAS, the Juvenile Court is outside the scope of authority of Executive to negotiate   
22 collective bargaining agreements as such authority is set forth in the Summit County Charter;   
23 and

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25 WHEREAS, said collective bargaining agreement contained, and continues to contain,   
26 certain terms of the agreement that are not consistent with the terms of the collective bargaining   
27 agreements concerning employees of the County’s Charter offices that have previously been   
28 negotiated by the Executive; and

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30 WHEREAS, although the aforementioned agreement is outside the scope of the   
31 Executive’s authority to negotiate collective bargaining agreements conferred by the Summit   
32 County Charter, Section 4117.10 of the Ohio Revised Code vests with this Council, as the   
33 legislative authority that appropriates funds for the Juvenile Court’s operation, the express   
34 authority to approve or reject the aforementioned agreement; and

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36 WHEREAS, the authority conferred under Section 4117.10 to approve or reject the   
37 aforementioned agreement is the authority to approve or reject the agreement as a whole, and the   
38 legislative authority does not have authority to reject certain provisions of the agreement while   
39 approving others; and

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41 WHEREAS, this Council approved the prior collective bargaining agreement as a whole   
42 in Resolution No. 2020-189, and one-time lump sums for certain bargaining unit employees in   
43 the year 2021 in Resolution 2021-137; and

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45 WHEREAS, while this Council does not favorably view the terms of the aforementioned   
46 agreement that differ from the terms of the collective bargaining agreements concerning   
47 employees of the County’s Charter offices, it nonetheless has again determined that approving   
48 the agreement as a whole is in the best interest of the County;

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4 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State  
5 of Ohio, that:

7 SECTION 1

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9 This Council hereby approves the collective bargaining agreement between the Court of  
10 Common Pleas-Juvenile Division and Teamsters Local #348, affiliated with the International  
11 Brotherhood of Teamsters, for the period 10/1/22 through 9/30/25.

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13 SECTION 2

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15 This Resolution is hereby declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety and  
16 welfare of the residents of the County of Summit and for the further purpose of timely complying  
17 with the provisions of Section 4117.10 of the Ohio Revised Code.

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19 SECTION 3

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21 Provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of eight members, it shall take  
22 effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Executive; otherwise, it shall take  
23 effect and be in force at the earliest time provided by law.

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25 SECTION 4

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27 It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating  
28 to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all  
29 deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action,  
30 were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section  
31 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
