A Resolution declaring the County of Summit's approval and support for the Western Reserve Land Conservancy's Clean Ohio Green Space Conservation Program Grant Application for the Pigeon Creek Preserve Project, located in Copley Township, in Council

District 5, to be submitted by the Western Reserve Land Conservancy for funding under the Clean Ohio Green Space Conservation Program, for the Executive, and declaring an

emergency.

WHEREAS, the Western Reserve Land Conservancy intends to submit a grant application to the Ohio Public Works Commission and the District 8 Natural Resources Assistance Council for the conservation and preservation of the Pigeon Creek Preserve Property (the "Project") which would preserve property between Pigeon Creek and Schocalog Run located in Copley Township, in Council District 5, for funding through the Clean Ohio Green Space Conservation Program (the "Clean Ohio Grant"); and

WHEREAS, preservation of the Project will protect natural resources including habitat for diverse plant and animal species, natural riparian corridors, and high-quality wetlands, and will help protect and maintain ground water supplies and water quality in the area; and

WHEREAS, the Western Reserve Land Conservancy is pursuing a plan to conserve and protect the Project in a thoughtful, conscientious and measured manner; and

WHEREAS, the County of Summit's approval and support is predicated on Copley Township's support of the Western Reserve Land Conservancy's Clean Ohio Grant Application; and

WHEREAS, it is in the best interest of the County of Summit to collaborate with the Western Reserve Land Conservancy and Copley Township in furtherance of conservation and preservation of the Project's natural resources; and

WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information, that it is necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit to declare its approval and support for the Western Reserve Land Conservancy's Clean Ohio Grant Application to be submitted for funding through the Clean Ohio Green Space Conservation Program;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State of Ohio, that:

SECTION 1

This Council hereby approves and supports the Western Reserve Land Conservancy's Clean Ohio Grant Application, located in Copley Township, in Council District 5, to be submitted to the Ohio Public Works Commission and the District 8 Natural Resources Assistance Council for funding through the Clean Ohio Green Space Conservation Program, in order to conserve and preserve the Pigeon Creek Preserve Property's natural resources, streams, and wetlands.
