7 **A Resolution authorizing the Executive to execute an agreement with Cardinal Parking**  
8 **Ltd. for the use by Cardinal of up to 20 parking spaces in the County of Summit Parking**  
9 **Deck for valet service, for one-year, at the rate of \$100.00 per month, for the Executive and**  
10 **declaring an emergency.**

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12 WHEREAS, Cardinal Parking Ltd. (“Cardinal”) provides valet services at various venues  
13 in downtown Akron and has recently been requested by Crave Restaurant to provide valet  
14 services for its patrons; and

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16 WHEREAS, in order to support the development of businesses in downtown Akron, the  
17 County is willing to permit Cardinal to utilize up to 20 parking spaces in the County of Summit  
18 Parking Deck (the “Deck”) at the rate of \$100.00 per month for the purposes of their valets  
19 parking cars for Crave customers; and

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21 WHEREAS, the monthly rate is different than the ordinary fee charged to other monthly  
22 customers of the Deck, who pay \$72.00 per month per section 113.14 of the Codified  
23 Ordinances; and

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25 WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information,  
26 that it is necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit to authorize the Executive to  
27 execute said agreement with Cardinal for valet services at Crave Restaurant;

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29 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the County of Summit,  
30 State of Ohio, that:

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32 SECTION 1

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34 The Executive is hereby authorized to execute the agreement with Cardinal Parking Ltd.  
35 for a one-year term at the amount of \$100.00 per month for up to 20 parking spaces for valet  
36 services to Crave Restaurant.

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38 SECTION 2

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40 This Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency in the interest of the health, safety  
41 and welfare of the residents of the County of Summit and for the further reason that it is  
42 necessary to promote business development in Akron.

44 SECTION 3

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46 Provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of eight members, it shall take  
47 effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Executive; otherwise, it shall take  
48 effect and be in force at the earliest time provided by law.
