7 **A Resolution confirming the award by the Board of Control of a professional service**  
8 **contract with Oriana House, Inc., as a Best Practical Source, for two full-time case**  
9 **managers and one full-time recovery support specialist, to provide support and treatment**  
10 **services to Valor Court participants, for a one-year term, from 9/30/22 through 9/29/23, in**  
11 **an amount not to exceed \$229,183.00, for the Court of Common Pleas-General Division,**  
12 **Adult Probation, and declaring an emergency.**

14 WHEREAS, this Council previously adopted Resolution No. 2020-091, which confirmed  
15 the award by the Board of Control of a professional service contract with Oriana House, Inc., as  
16 a Best Practical Source, for two full-time case managers and one full-time recovery support  
17 specialist, to provide support and treatment services to Valor Court participants, for a one-year  
18 term, from 9/30/19 through 9/29/20, in an amount not to exceed \$210,332.00; and

20 WHEREAS, this Council subsequently adopted Resolution No. 2021-015, which  
21 confirmed the award by the Board of Control of a professional service contract with Oriana  
22 House, Inc., as a Best Practical Source, for two full-time case managers and one full-time  
23 recovery support specialist, to provide support and treatment services to Valor Court participants,  
24 for a one-year term, from 9/30/20 through 9/29/21, in an amount not to exceed \$216,388.49; and

26 WHEREAS, this Council subsequently adopted Resolution No. 2021-277, which  
27 confirmed the award by the Board of Control of a professional service contract with Oriana  
28 House, Inc., as a Best Practical Source, for two full-time case managers and one full-time  
29 recovery support specialist, to provide support and treatment services to Valor Court participants,  
30 for a one-year term, from 9/30/21 through 9/29/22, in an amount not to exceed \$216,388.49; and

32 WHEREAS, based on performance reviews and Oriana House Inc.'s specialized  
33 knowledge and previous years working with the Valor Court, the Court of Common Pleas-  
34 General Division, Adult Probation, wishes to enter into a professional service contract with  
35 Oriana House, Inc., as a Best Practical Source pursuant to Sections 177.01(h)(4)D. and  
36 177.07(a)(5) of the Codified Ordinances of the County of Summit, for a one-year term, from  
37 9/30/22 through 9/29/23, in an amount not to exceed \$229,183.00, to be funded by a Fiscal Year  
38 2023 Treatment Drug Courts grant from the United States Department of Health and Human  
39 Services, Substance Abuse and Mental Health Services Administration ("SAMSHA") for the  
40 Valor Court Expansion and Enhancement Project; and

42 WHEREAS, the Board of Control, at its meeting held November 2, 2022, awarded said  
43 professional service contract with Oriana House, Inc., as a Best Practical Source, for a one-year  
44 term, from 9/30/22 through 9/29/23, in an amount not to exceed \$229,183.00, subject to  
45 confirmation by Council; and

47 WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information,  
48 that the aforementioned renewal of the professional service contract with Oriana House, Inc. is  
49 necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit;

51 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State

4 SECTION 1

6 The award by the Board of Control of a professional service contract with Oriana House,  
7 Inc., as a Best Practical Source, for two full-time case managers and one full-time recovery  
8 support specialist, to provide support and treatment services to Valor Court participants, for a  
9 one-year term, from 9/30/22 through 9/29/23, in an amount not to exceed \$229,183.00, is hereby  
10 confirmed and the Executive is hereby authorized to execute said professional service contract  
11 and any other necessary related documents.

13 SECTION 2

15 This Resolution is declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety, and welfare  
16 of the residents of the County of Summit, and for the further reason that it immediately  
17 authorizes necessary support and treatment services for Valor Court participants.

19 SECTION 3

21 Provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of eight members, it shall take  
22 effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Executive; otherwise, it shall take  
23 effect and be in force at the earliest time provided by law.

27 It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating  
28 to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all  
29 deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were

31 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
