RESOLUTION NO. 2022-359

A Resolution authorizing the Executive to terminate the enterprise zone agreement between the County of Summit, the City of Cuyahoga Falls, and Kyocera SGS Precision Tools, Inc. that allowed tax incentives within the Cuyahoga Falls Enterprise Zone, located in Council District 3, and declaring an emergency.

WHEREAS, pursuant to Chapter 5709 of the Ohio Revised Code, this Council previously adopted Resolution No. 95-598 and Resolution No. 96-132, which created and amended the Cuyahoga Falls Enterprise Zone, located in Council District 3, to encourage job creation and economic development within the County; and

WHEREAS the County induces economic growth by exempting certain taxes imposed on industry where said industry creates or retains jobs within a certified enterprise zone; and

WHEREAS, the Council of the City of Cuyahoga Falls ("Cuyahoga Falls") authorized its Mayor to enter into an enterprise zone agreement with the County and Kyocera SGS Precision Tools, Inc. (the "Enterprise Zone Agreement") to offer tax incentives for an eligible project within the zone, subject to approval by the Executive; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Resolution No. 2020-035, passed March 2, 2020, the County authorized the Executive to execute the Enterprise Zone Agreement for investments by Kyocera SGS Precision Tools, Inc. within the City of Cuyahoga Falls Enterprise Zone, located in Council District 3; and

WHEREAS, the Enterprise Zone Agreement was subsequently executed by the City, County and Kyocera SGS Precision Tools, Inc. in 2020; and

WHEREAS, the Fiscal Office determined the value of improvements located at 238 Marc Drive, Cuyahoga Falls, Ohio 44223, after reappraisal of the property at that address, and such value does not rise to the level to warrant a tax abatement pursuant to the Enterprise Zone Agreement; and

WHEREAS, for the reason set forth above, Kyocera SGS Precision Tools, Inc. has not met the investment terms outlined in the Enterprise Zone Agreement; and

WHEREAS, the County's Tax Incentive Review Council met in 2021, and based on all of the above, voted to recommend the termination of the Enterprise Zone Agreement; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Resolution 2021-373, this Council accepted the recommendation of the County's Tax Incentive Review Council to terminate the Enterprise Zone Agreement, and pursuant to Resolution 84-2021, the Council of the City accepted the recommendation of the County's Tax Incentive Review Council to terminate the Enterprise Zone Agreement; and

WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information that is necessary and in the best interest of the County to authorize the Executive to terminate the Enterprise Zone Agreement;
