7 **A Resolution confirming the award by the Board of Control of a construction contract with**
8 **Black Horse Bridge Construction, Inc., to replace the bridge on Pressler Road**
9 **approximately 0.2 miles south of Killian Road, located in Springfield Township, in Council**
10 **District 8, in an amount not to exceed \$932,941.50, for the Engineer, and declaring an**
11 **emergency.**

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13 WHEREAS, the Engineer wishes to replace the poorly conditioned, structurally deficient,
14 load posted two-span concrete slab structure with a new bridge on Pressler Road approximately
15 0.2 miles south of Killian Road, in Springfield Township (the "Project"); and

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17 WHEREAS, this Council previously adopted Resolution No. 2021-025, which confirmed
18 the award by the Board of Control of a professional service contract with MS Consultants, Inc.
19 for design work for the Project in 2021 and 2022 with construction to begin in 2023; and

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21 WHEREAS, the Project will be submitted to this Council as part of the Capital
22 Improvements Program for 2023-2028; and

24 WHEREAS, the Engineer sent out six bid packages for the Project and four bids were
25 received and the Executive selected Black Horse Bridge Construction, Inc. as the lowest
26 responsive and responsible bidder; and

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28 WHEREAS, the Board of Control, at its meeting held January 4, 2023, awarded a
29 construction contract with Black Horse Bridge Construction, Inc., for the project, located in
30 Springfield Township, in Council District 8, in an amount not to exceed \$932,941.50, subject to
31 confirmation by this Council; and

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33 WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information,
34 that the aforementioned construction contract with Black Horse Bridge Construction, Inc. is
35 necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit;

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37 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State

42 The award by the Board of Control of a construction contract with Black Horse Bridge
43 Construction, Inc. to replace the bridge on Pressler Road approximately 0.2 miles south of
44 Killian Road (the "Project"), located in Springfield Township, in Council District 8, in an
45 amount not to exceed \$932,941.50, is hereby confirmed and the Executive is hereby authorized
46 to execute said construction contract and any other necessary related documents.

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10 Provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of eight members, it shall take
11 effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Executive; otherwise, it shall take
12 effect and be in force at the earliest time provided by law.

20 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.


