 A Resolution authorizing the Executive to settle any or all claims, and to execute any corresponding settlement agreements, in litigation titled County of Summit, Ohio v Express Scripts, Inc., et al, 23-op-45001-DAP, before Judge Dan Aaron Polster in the United States District Court, Northern District of Ohio, for the Executive's Department of Law, Insurance and Risk Management, and declaring an emergency.

WHEREAS, this Council previously adopted Resolution No. 2019-332 authorizing the Executive to settle any or all claims, and to execute any corresponding settlement agreements, in litigation titled In re: National Prescription Opiate Litigation, Case No. 1:17-MD-2804, before Judge Dan Aaron Polster in the United States District Court, Northern District of Ohio, with any manufacturing or distributor Defendant with less than a 10% share of the opioid market in Summit County; and

WHEREAS, this Council subsequently adopted Resolution No. 2019-361 authorizing the Executive to expand the scope of this authorization to further authorize the Executive to settle any or all claims, and to execute any corresponding settlement agreements, in litigation titled In re: National Prescription Opiate Litigation, Case No. 1:17-MD-2804, before Judge Dan Aaron Polster in the United States District Court, Northern District of Ohio, with any manufacturing or distributor Defendant, regardless of market share of the opioid market in Summit County and to additionally authorize settlement with Pharmacy Defendants; and

WHEREAS, the Executive has retained the law firm of Motley Rice to continue to represent the County in subsequent litigation; and

WHEREAS, due to discovery and depositions conducted in the prior actions, Motley Rice identified for the County and the Executive has initiated litigation against the County's Prescription Benefits Managers for their participation in the Opioid Epidemic that has so adversely affected the residents of Summit County in litigation titled County of Summit, Ohio v Express Scripts, Inc., et al, 23-op-45001-DAP, before Judge Dan Aaron Polster in the United States District Court, Northern District of Ohio (the "Lawsuit"); and

WHEREAS, in the Lawsuit, the County has sued several Defendants who are or were, at all times relevant to the County's Complaint, Prescription Benefit Managers for the County; and

WHEREAS, it is possible that the County may reach a settlement of any or all claims asserted by the County in the Lawsuit against one or more of the Prescription Benefit Managers for the County during the time in which the County asserts the actions of the Defendants transpired; and

WHEREAS, the Executive cannot settle any or all such claims brought in the Lawsuit against such Defendants and execute any corresponding settlement agreements without authority provided by this Council; and

WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information, that it is necessary and in the best interest of the County to authorize the Executive to settle any or all claims, and to execute any corresponding settlement agreements, in the Lawsuit, with any

Prescription Benefit Managers for the County during the time in which the County asserts the actions of the Defendants transpired;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the County of Summit, State of Ohio, that:

SECTION 1

 The Executive's hiring of Motley Rice to provide further counsel is ratified and she is hereby authorized to settle any or all claims, and to execute any corresponding settlement agreements, in the litigation titled County of Summit, Ohio v Express Scripts, Inc., et al, 23-op-45001-DAP, before Judge Dan Aaron Polster in the United States District Court, Northern District of Ohio (the "Lawsuit") against the Prescription Benefit Managers for the County during the time in which the County asserts the actions of the Defendants transpired. The Executive is further authorized to take any action and to execute any other documents necessary to effectuate the settlement of the claims authorized under this Section.

SECTION 2

This Resolution is hereby declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety and welfare of the residents of the County of Summit and for the further reason to immediately authorize any of the aforementioned settlements to occur in a timely fashion and in accordance with applicable laws and rules governing such settlements.

SECTION 3

Provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of eight members, it shall take effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Executive; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force at the earliest time provided by law.

SECTION 4

It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
